Cutting Instructions

Burgundy, Sage, Cheddar: Cut (1) strip 1½" x 15" long from each

Black, Sage: Cut (4) squares 1½" from each

Beige: Cut (4) strips 1½" x 2½" and (4) strips 1½" x 3½"
(OR – for Alternate cutting & piecing method: Cut (1) 1½" wide x at least 26" long*)

Block Instructions

1. Sew burgundy strip to sage strip. Sew cheddar strip to the other side of the sage. Press. From this pieced strip, cut (4) 3½" sections. (Fig. 1)
2. Sew one sage square to each of the four 2½" beige strips. Sew one black square to each of the four 3½" beige strips.

(*As an alternate piecing method, stitch the first sage square to the beige strip, right sides together. Without removing the piece from the sewing machine, trim the beige strip to 2½" long, Stitch the next sage square to the remaining length of beige strip, and again trim the beige strip to 2½" long. (Fig. 2) Repeat until you have the four sage-tipped strips, and four black-tipped strips. Cut strips apart; press. (Fig. 3 & 4).

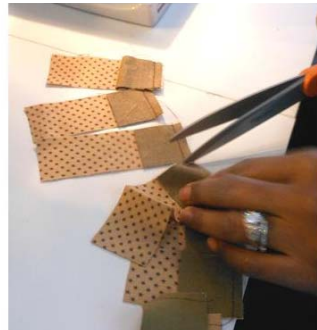

3. Stitch the green-tipped strips to the four Rail Fence sections, lining up the sage square and cheddar strip as shown. (Fig. 5)
4. Stitch the black-tipped strips to the units, lining up the black square to the burgundy corner as shown. (Fig. 6)
5. Join the four units as shown; square up. (Fig. 7)
