Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Fabric A – Gray Tape 8320-0144 1/3 yard

Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric B – Cream Yardstick 8314-0147 1/4 yard

Cut four 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 1 1/4" x 11" strips.

Fabric C – Taupe Toolbox 8222-0144 1/2 yard

Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 8 1/2" squares.

Cut three 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 1/4" x 11" strips.

Fabric D – Copper Toolbox 8222-0157 1/4 yard

Cut four 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 1 1/4" x 11" strips.

Fabric E – Gold Inches 8317-0133 1/3 yard

Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric F – Taupe/Cream Numbers 8315-0144 1/4 yard

Cut four 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 1 1/4" x 11" strips.

Fabric G – Taupe/Cream Lines 8316-0144 1/3 yard

Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into five 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric H – Gold Toolbox 8222-0133 1/4 yard

Cut four 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 1 1/4" x 11" strips.

Fabric I – Copper Yardstick 8314-0157 1/3 yard

Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric J – Gold/Cream Lines 8316-0133 1/4 yard

Cut four 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 1 1/4" x 11" strips.

Fabric K – Gold Carpenters Pencil 8313-0133 1/3 yard

Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three 8 1/2" squares.

Fabric L – Copper/Taupe Inches 8317-0157 1/3 yard

Cut seven 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty 1 1/4" x 11" strips.

Fabric M – Taupe Carpenters Pencil 8313-0147 1/3 yard

Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 8 1/2" squares.

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Fabric N – Gray Level 8321-0144 5/8 yard
 Cut three 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ¼" x 11" strips.
 Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric O – Taupe Scale 8312-0144 1/3 yard
 Cut one 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 8 ½" squares.

Fabric P – Taupe Level 8321-0147 1/4 yard
 Cut three 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ¼" x 11" strips.

Fabric Q – Taupe Scale 8312-0147 1/3 yard
 Cut one 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 8 ½" squares.

Fabric R – Taupe Tape 8320-0147 1/3 yard
 Cut one 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 8 ½" squares.

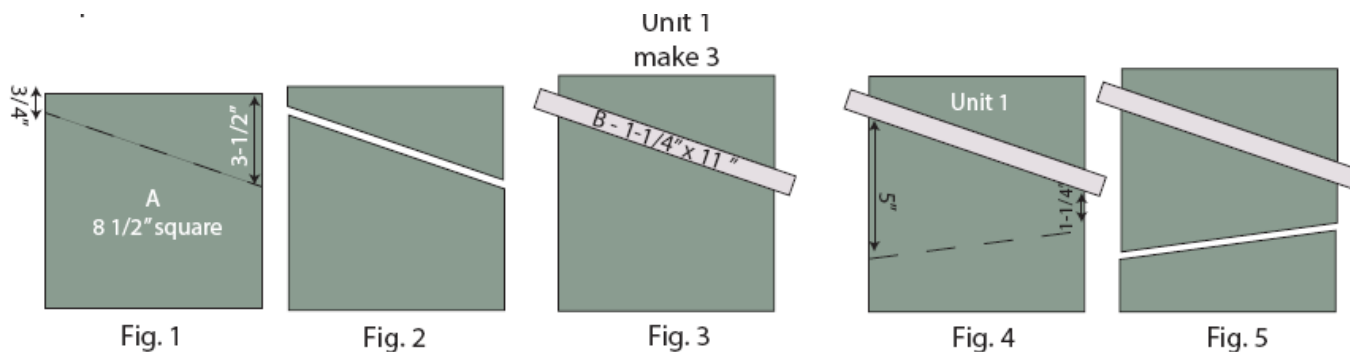
Fabric S – Gold/Cream Numbers 8315-0133 1/4 yard
 Cut three 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ¼" x 11" strips.

Fabric T – Gold Scale 8312-0133 1/4 yard
 Cut three 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1 ¼" x 11" strips.

Backing – Taupe Yardstick 8314-0147 2 ¾ yards
 Cut two 48" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 48" x 56" back.

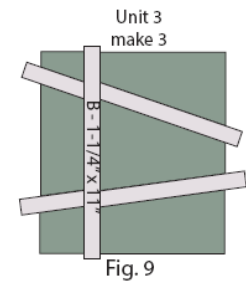
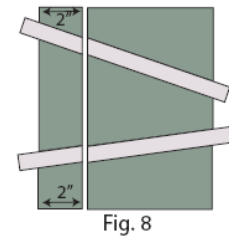
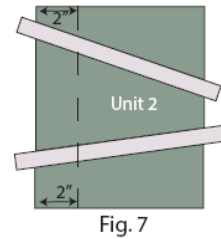
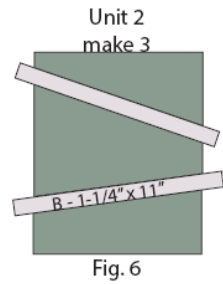
Block Assembly

- 1) Follow Figure 1 and draw a line from the left side to the right side of one 8 ½" Fabric A square. The line starts ¾" down from the top on the left side and down 3 ½" from the top on the right side of the Fabric A square (Fig. 1).
- 2) Cut the square into two pieces along the line drawn in Step 1 (Fig. 2).
- 3) Sew one Fabric A piece to each side of one 1 ¼" x 11" Fabric B strip (Fig. 3).
- 4) Follow Figure 4 and draw a line from the lower left side of the Fabric A piece, 5" below the Fabric B strip to 1 ¼" below the Fabric B strip on the right side of the Fabric A piece. Cut the piece along the drawn line (Fig. 5).

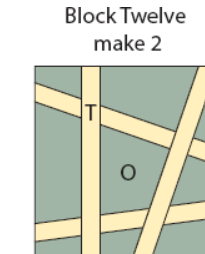
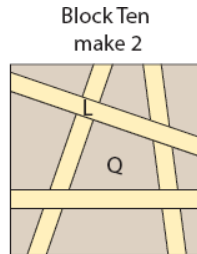
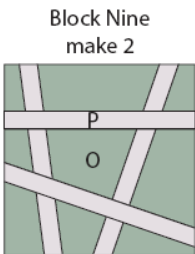
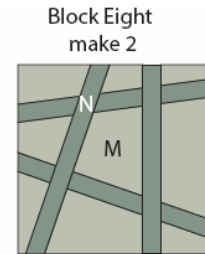
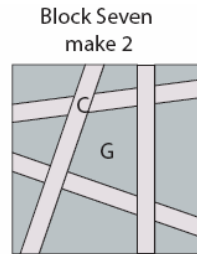
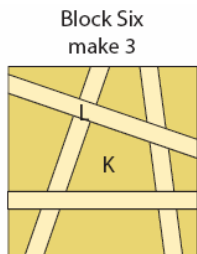
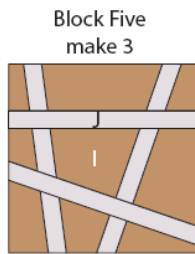
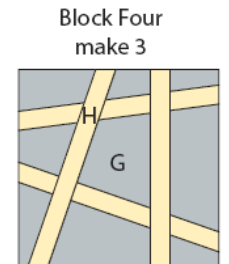
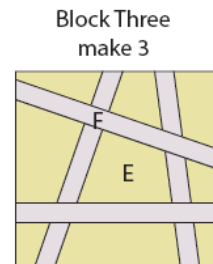
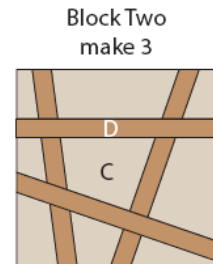
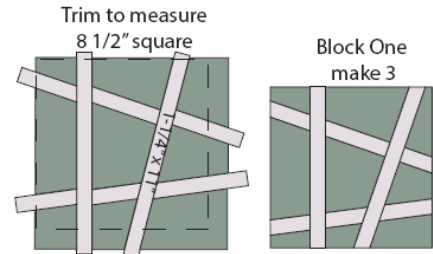
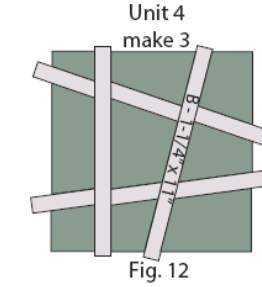
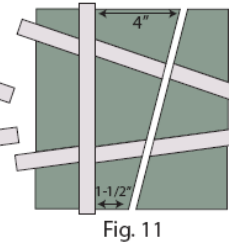
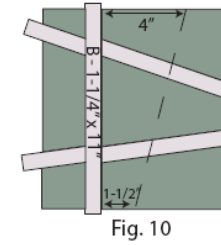


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- 5) Re-join the Fabric A pieces with (1) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric B strip in between them. (Fig. 6).
- 6) Draw a line from the top to the bottom of the Fabric A piece, 2" from the left side at the top and 2" from the bottom (Fig. 7). Cut the piece along the drawn line (Fig. 8).
- 7) Re-join the two Fabric A pieces with (1) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric B strip in between them (Fig. 9).



- 8) Draw a line from the top of the Fabric A piece, 4" to the right of the Fabric B strip to a point on the bottom of the Fabric A piece, 1 1/2" from the Fabric B strip (Fig. 10). Cut along the drawn line (Fig. 11).
- 9) Re-join the (2) Fabric A pieces with (1) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric B strip in between them (Fig. 12).
- 10) Starting at the upper left corner, trim the Fabric A piece to measure 8 1/2" square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 13).
- 11) Repeat Steps 1-10 to make (3) Block Ones total.
- 12) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (3) 8 1/2" Fabric C squares and (12) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric D strips to make (3) Block Twos (Fig. 14).
- 13) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (3) 8 1/2" Fabric E squares and (12) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric F strips to make (3) Block Threes (Fig. 15).
- 14) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (3) 8 1/2" Fabric G squares and (12) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric H strips to make (3) Block Fours (Fig. 16).
- 15) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (3) 8 1/2" Fabric I squares and (12) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric J strips to make (3) Block Fives (Fig. 17).
- 16) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (3) 8 1/2" Fabric K squares and (12) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric L strips to make (3) Block Sixes (Fig. 18).
- 17) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (2) 8 1/2" Fabric G squares and (8) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric C strips to make (2) Block Sevens (Fig. 19).
- 18) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (2) 8 1/2" Fabric M squares and (8) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric N strips to make (2) Block Eights (Fig. 20).
- 19) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (2) 8 1/2" Fabric O squares and (8) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric P strips to make (2) Block Nines (Fig. 21).
- 20) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (2) 8 1/2" Fabric Q squares and (8) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric L strips to make (2) Block Tens (Fig. 22).
- 21) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (2) 8 1/2" Fabric R squares and (8) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric S strips to make (2) Block Elevens (Fig. 23).
- 22) Repeat Steps 1-10 using (2) 8 1/2" Fabric O squares and (8) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric T strips to make (2) Block Twelves (Fig. 24).

Quilt Assembly *(refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top)*

- 23) Sew (1) of each Block One thru Block Five together to make Row One.
- 24) Sew (1) of each Block Six thru Block Ten together to make Row Two.
- 25) Sew (1) Block Eleven, (1) Block Twelve, (1) Block One, (1) Block Two and (1) Block Three together to make Row Three.
- 26) Sew (1) of each Block Four thru Block Eight together to make Row Four.
- 27) Sew (1) Block Nine, (1) Block Ten, (1) Eleven, (1) Block Twelve and (1) Block One together to make Row Five.
- 28) Sew (1) of each Block Two thru Block Six together to make Row Six.
- 29) Sew the (6) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
- 30) Layer and quilt as desired.
- 31) Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
- 32) Bind as desired.
