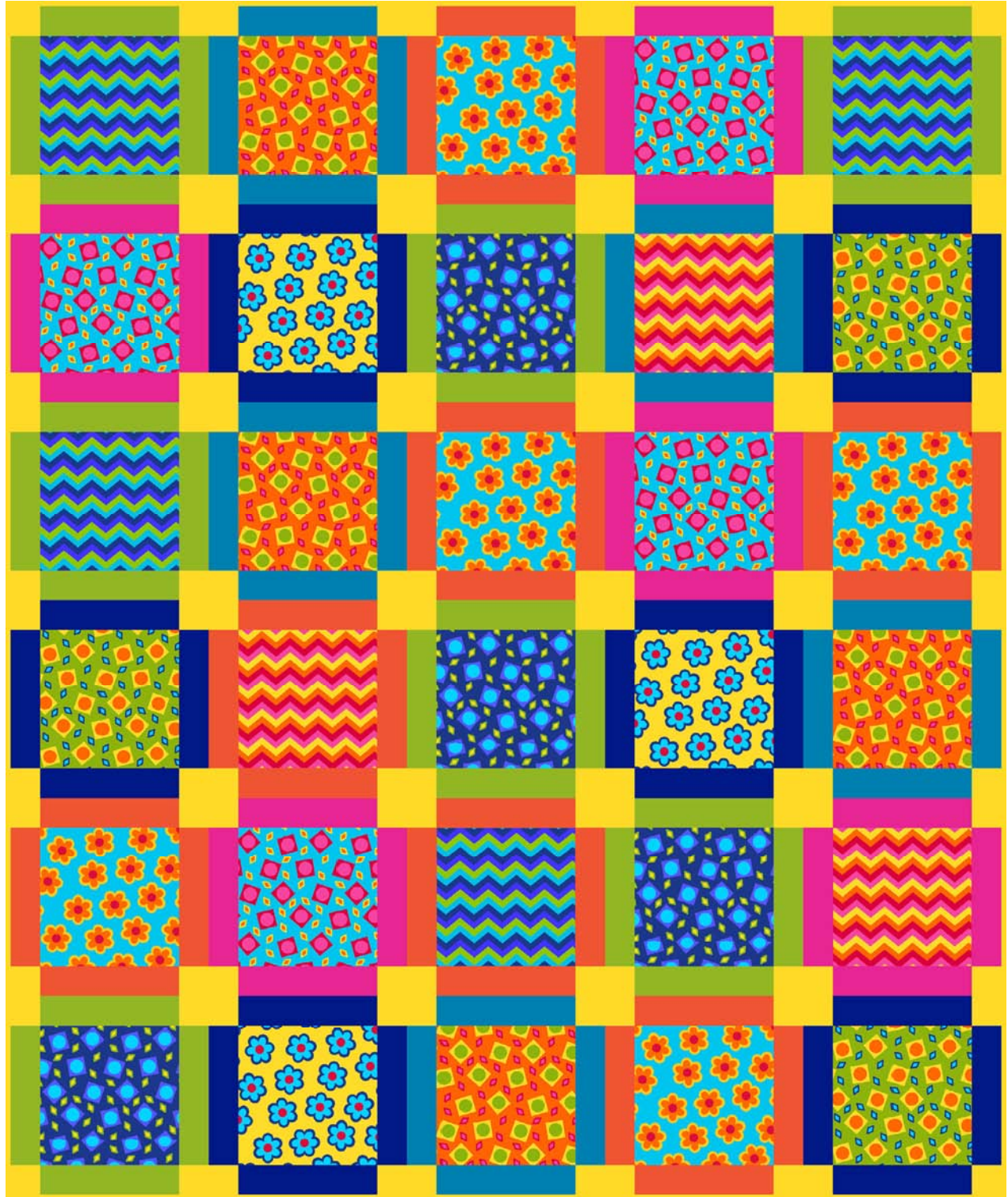

Fabric A- Blue Chevron	0850-0219	¼ yard
Fabric B- Pink Chevron	0850-0228	¼ yard
Fabric C- Lime Boxes	0851-0214	¼ yard
Fabric D- Blue Boxes	0851-0219	¼ yard
Fabric E- Orange Boxes	0851-0228	¼ yard
Fabric F- Navy Boxes	0851-0260	¼ yard
Fabric G- Yellow Flowers	0852-0233	¼ yard
Fabric H- Blue Flowers	0852-0219	¼ yard
Fabric I- Yellow	3390 Sunshine	1 yard
Fabric J- Orange	0082 Orange	½ yard
Fabric K- Turquoise	0089 Turquoise	⅓ yard
Fabric L- Lime	0090 Lime	½ yard
Fabric M- Pink	0092- Bright Pink	1/3 yard
Fabric N- Navy	0094-Royal Blue	½ yard
Backing	Your Choice	3 ¾ yards

**Cutting Instructions:****Fabric A**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 7½" squares.

**Fabric B**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into three 7½" squares.

**Fabric C**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into three 7½" squares.

**Fabric D**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 7½" squares.

**Fabric E**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 7½" squares.

**Fabric F**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 7½" squares.

**Fabric G**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into three 7½" squares.

**Fabric H**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into five 7½" squares.

**Fabric I**

Cut six 2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into (120) 2" squares.

Cut six 2 ½" x 42" strips for the binding.

**Fabric J**

Cut two 7 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-eight 2" x 7 ½" strips.

**Fabric K**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into twenty 2" x 7 ½" strips.

**Fabric L**

Cut two 7 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-eight 2" x 7 ½" strips.

**Fabric M**

Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into twenty 2" x 7 ½" strips.

**Fabric N**

Cut two 7 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 2" x 7 ½" strips.

**Backing**

Cut two 58" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make one 58" x 68" backing piece.

**Assembly Instructions:**

1. Follow Figure 1 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric A square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric J strips to make one A/J block.
2. Follow Figure 2 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric A square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric L strips to make one A/L block. Repeat to make three A/L blocks total.
3. Follow Figure 3 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric B square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric J strips to make one B/J block.
4. Follow Figure 4 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric B square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric M strips to make one B/M block.
5. Follow Figure 5 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric B square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric K strips to make one B/K block.
6. Follow Figure 6 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric C square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric N strips to make one C/N block. Repeat to make three C/N blocks total.
7. Follow Figure 7 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric D square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric M strips to make one D/M block. Repeat to make four D/M blocks total.
8. Follow Figure 8 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric E square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric K strips to make one E/K block. Repeat to make four E/K blocks total.
9. Follow Figure 9 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric F square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric L strips to make one F/L block. Repeat to make four F/L blocks total.
10. Follow Figure 10 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric G square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric N strips to make one G/N block. Repeat to make three G/N blocks total.
11. Follow Figure 11 to sew together one 7 1/2" Fabric H square, four 2" Fabric I squares and four 2" x 7 1/2" Fabric J strips to make one H/J block. Repeat to make five H/F blocks total.
12. Refer to the quilt layout below to arrange the blocks into six rows with five blocks in each.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the six 2 1/2" x 42" Fabric I strips together end-to-end with 45° seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.
