

# *Aunt Grace* Baskets of Scraps

## Child's Quilt

Fabric by Judie Rothermel



Finished Size: 51" x 51"

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS AND CUTTING GUIDE:

#### From the solid cream – 1 ½ yards (5901-2174)

Cut 16 squares, 6 ¼" x 6 ¼" – cut each square in half diagonally from corner to corner in both directions for a total of 64 side triangles (blocks)

Cut 32 squares, 3 ¾" x 3 ¾" – cut each square in half diagonally in one direction for a total of 64 corner triangles (blocks)

Cut 40 rectangles, 2" x 9 ½" (sashing)

#### From the solid Dresden – 7/8 yard (5901-0039)

Cut 6 strips, 2 ¼" x width of fabric; stitch these strips together end-to-end for binding; press seams open

Cut 5 strips, 2" x width of fabric; stitch these strips together end-to-end as needed to cut 2 border strips, 2" x 44" and 2 strips, 2" x 47" (inner border)

Cut 25 squares, 2" x 2" (sashing-cornerstones)

#### From the light conversational print – ½ yard (8089-0328)

Cut 5 strips, 2 ½" x width of fabric; stitch these strips together end-to-end as needed to cut 2 border strips, 2 ½" x 47" and 2 border strips, 2 ½" x 51"

#### From the 9 assorted prints – Fat 8th (8079-0326, 8080-0311, 8080-0333, 8089-0314, 8082-0335, 8087-0322, 8087-0328, 8090-0311, 8090-0314)

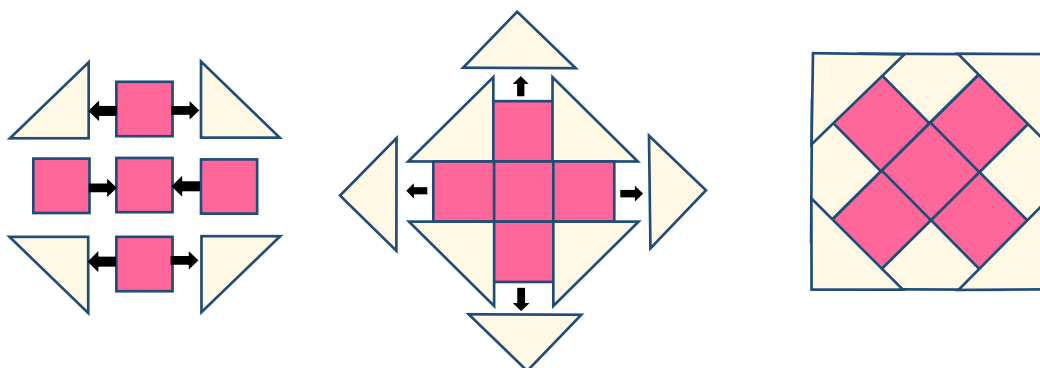
Cut a total of 80 squares, 3 ½" x 3 ½" (10 squares from each of 7 Fat 8ths and 5 squares from each of the remaining 2 Fat 8ths)

*(All seams are sewn right sides together with a ¼" seam allowance unless otherwise specified.)*

### Making the Blocks: Make 16 (9 ½" x 9 ½" unfinished)

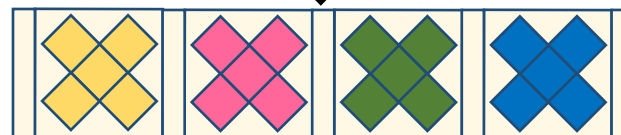
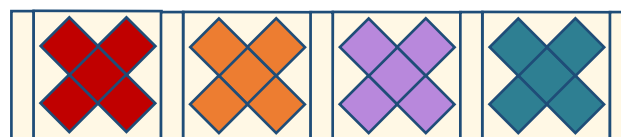
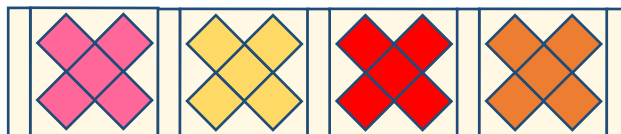
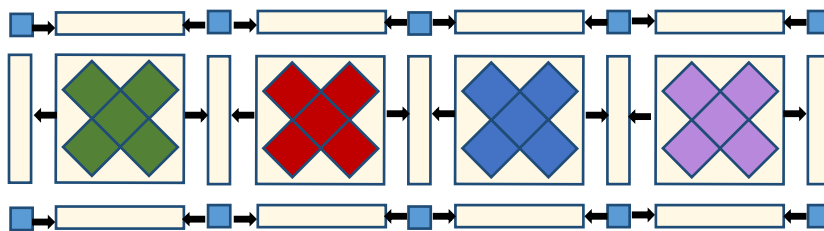
**(Note: The side and corner triangles are oversized so that the block can be squared up to an exact 9 ½" x 9 ½")**

1. Using 5 matching 3 ½" print squares and 4 solid cream side triangles, stitch the block together as shown below, pressing towards the arrows.
2. Stitch the rows together. Stitch 4 solid cream corner triangles to the block.
3. Trim the block as needed to square up to 9 ½" x 9 ½".



**Assembly:**

1. Stitch the blocks, the 2" x 9 1/2" solid cream sashing rectangles and the 2" x 2" solid Dresden cornerstones together as shown, pressing towards the arrows. Stitch the rows together.



2. Stitch a 2" x 44" solid Dresden border to each side of the quilt, pressing to the border. Stitch a 2" x 47" solid Dresden border to the top and bottom. (Refer to diagram on the following page)
3. Stitch a 2 1/2" x 47" light conversation border to each side of the quilt, followed by a 2 1/2" x 51" border to the top and bottom. (Refer to diagram on the following page)
4. Quilt as desired and bind with the 2 1/4" solid Dresden binding strip.
