## Fabric Requirements and Cutting Guide

**Fabric A** 2321-0175 2-1/2 yards border stripe  
Fussy cut (2) 5-1/2" x 60-1/2" side borders on the length of fabric (cut these borders first)  
Fussy cut (3) 5-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end matching fabric design, then fussy cut:  
(2) 5-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom/borders

**Fabric B** 4828-0188 3/4 yard Civil War ladies  
Fussy cut:  
(11) 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" squares for star block centers

**Fabric C** 4829-0114 1/4 yard green with white leaf print  
Cut (3) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces for log cabin blocks

**Fabric D** 4829-0122 1/3 yard teal with white leaf print  
Cut (6) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces

**Fabric E** 4830-0111 1/4 yard cream with red figures  
Cut (2) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

**Fabric F** 4830-0122 1/4 yard cream with green figures  
Cut (2) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces

**Fabric G** 4832-0111 1/4 yard dark red print  
Cut (4) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

**Fabric H** 4832-0122 1 yard dark blue print  
Cut (6) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces  
Cut (1) 5-1/2" x wof strip, from this strip cut:  
(4) 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" border cornerstone squares  
Cut (7) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding

**Fabric I** 4834-0111 1 yard red allover print  
Cut (5) 2-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut:  
(2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" side borders and (2) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom borders  
Cut (7) 2-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(24) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares for log cabin block centers and (88) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares for star points

**Fabric J** 4836-0126 1/3 yard red floral print  
Cut (4) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces for log cabin blocks

**Fabric K** 4836-0126 1/4 yard purple floral print  
Cut (3) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces for log cabin blocks



**Fabric L** 4841-0122 1/3 yard red/green leaf stripe  
Cut (4) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces for log cabin blocks

**Fabric M** 4841-0126 1/4 yard teal/brown leaf stripe  
Cut (4) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(12) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (12) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces

**Fabric N** 4845-0188 1 yard cream mini print  
Cut (5) 2-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(44) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for star blocks  
Cut (3) 2-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(44) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares for star blocks  
Cut (8) 1-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut:  
(24) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces and (24) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" pieces

## Instructions

**Log Cabin blocks:** Log Cabin blocks are constructed by sewing strips of fabric in rounds to a center square. Strips are added in a clockwise direction with the new strip on top and the already sewn part of the block on the bottom as it feeds through the sewing machine. Blocks A and B begin with a fabric I 2-1/2" center square.

**Log Cabin Block A:** round 1 progression: fabric F 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips and fabric K 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips. Round 2 progression: fabric L 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips and fabric G 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. Round 3 progression: fabric N 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips and fabric D 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. Make 12 blocks A.

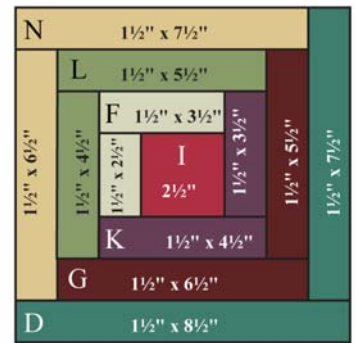
**Log Cabin Block B:** round 1 progression: fabric E 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips and fabric C 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips. Round 2 progression: fabric M 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips and fabric J 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. Round 3 progression: fabric N 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips and fabric H 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" and 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. Make 12 blocks B.

**Star Blocks:** Position a fabric I 2-1/2" square on one end of a fabric N 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew in a diagonal line from corner to corner on the fabric I square. Trim 1/4" from stitched line, fold out triangle and press seam. Repeat on the opposite corner to make a star point unit. Make 44 star point units. Sew a star point unit to opposite sides of a fabric B fussy cut 4-1/2" square. Sew a fabric N 2-1/2" square to each end of the remaining star point units. Sew these units to the top/bottom of the star center assembly to complete a star block. Make 11 star blocks.

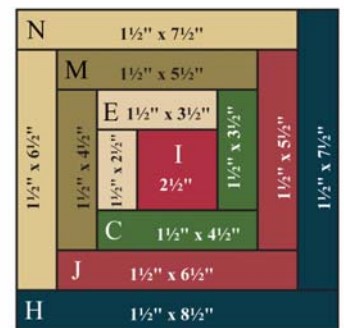
**Quilt Assembly:** The quilt is sewn together in seven rows of blocks with five blocks in each row. Refer to the assembly diagram for the orientation of the log cabin blocks, the placement of blocks A and B and the star blocks in each row. Begin with the first row at the top of the quilt center. As each successive row is completed, add it to the row above until all seven rows are completed.

**Borders:** Center and sew the fabric A side borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew a fabric H 6-1/2" square to each end of the fabric A top/bottom borders. Sew these borders to the top/ bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt.

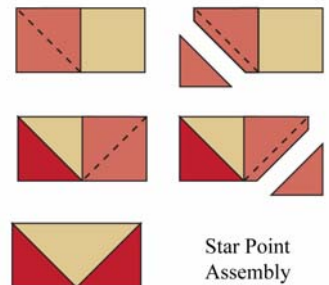
**Finishing:** Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt the layers together. Bind to finish the outside edges.



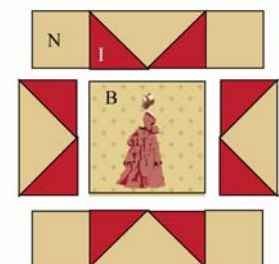
Block A
