# **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE**

Quilt Size 54" x 56"

# Fabric A New Christmas Panel

0492-0122 1 panel

• Fussy cut the large panel ¼" outside the teal border (approx. 14 ½" x 16 ½")

• Fussy cut four small panels ¼" outside the teal border (approx. 6 ½" x 7 ½")

#### Fabric B White Hearts

0495-0140

¼ yard

• Cut one 4 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 4 ½" squares and four 3 ½" squares.

Fabric C White Holly

0497-0140

14 yard

• Cut one 3 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 3 ½" squares.

# Fabric D Light Blue Snowflakes

0496-0122

1 yard

• Cut two 6 7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into eight 6 7/8" squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make sixteen large triangles.

• Cut one 12 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into eight 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips and eight 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

# Fabric E Teal Hearts

0495-0122

1 yard

• Cut six 4 ½" x 42" strips. Sew together and cut to make two 4 ½" x 54 ½" strips and two 4 ½" x 48 ½" strips.

#### Fabric F Dark Blue Snowflakes

0496-0110

1 yard

- Cut two 3 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into two 3 ½" x 20 ½" strips and two 3 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- Cut one 12 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into eight 3 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- Cut one 7 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into eight 3 ½" x 7 ½" strips.

# Fabric G Red Holly

0497-0111

3/8 yard

- Cut one 5 1/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into eight 5 1/8" squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make sixteen small triangles.
- Cut one 4 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 4 ½" squares and four 3 ½" squares.

# Fabric H Multi Stripe

0493-0122

1/4 yard

• Cut one 4 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 4 ½" squares and four 3 ½" squares.

### Fabric I Tossed Snowmen

0494-0122

14 yard

• Cut one 6 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 6 ½" squares.

Fabric J Red

0498-0111

1 yard

- Cut six 2 ½" x 42" strips. Sew together and cut to make two 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips and two 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- Cut six 2 ½" x 42" strips for the binding.

# **Backing White Hearts**



1 vards

• Cut two 62" x 42" strips. Sew together and trim to make one 62" x 64" backing.

# **Block Assembly Instructions**


- 1) Sew one 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the 14  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew one 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A panel (Fig. 1). Trim the block to 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (Fig. 2).
- 2) Sew one 3 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of one 6 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric A small panel. Sew one 3 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A small panel (Fig. 3). Trim the block to 10 ½" x 10 ½" (Fig. 4).





# **Block Assembly Instructions**

- 3) Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Fabric A block. Sew one 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A block to complete one Corner Block (Fig. 5).
- 4) Repeat Steps 1-3 to make a total of four Corner Blocks.
- 5) Sew one Fabric G small triangle to each side of a 6 ½" Fabric I square to make one Middle Block Center (Fig. 6).
- 6) Sew one Fabric D triangle to each side of the Fabric I block to complete one 12 ½" Middle Block square (Fig. 7).
- 7) Repeat Steps 5-6 to make a total of four Middle Blocks.
- 8) Sew one 4 ½" Fabric B square, one 4 ½" Fabric G square and one 4 ½" Fabric H square together to make one pieced side strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a total of four strips.
- 9) Sew one 3 ½" Fabric B square, one 3 ½" Fabric G square, one 3 ½" Fabric C and one 3 ½" Fabric H square together to make one pieced top/bottom strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a total of four strips.



# Quilt Top Assembly Instructions- Refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top.

- 10) Sew one pieced side strip to the top and bottom of two Middle Blocks to make the side borders. Sew one border strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 11) Sew two Corner Blocks, one Middle Block and two top/bottom strips together alternating the blocks and strips to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
- 12) Sew one 2 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 13) Sew one 4 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt. Sew one 4 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 14) Layer and quilt as desired.
- 15) Sew the six 2 ½" x 42" Fabric J strips together end-to-end with 45 seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16) Bind as desired.
