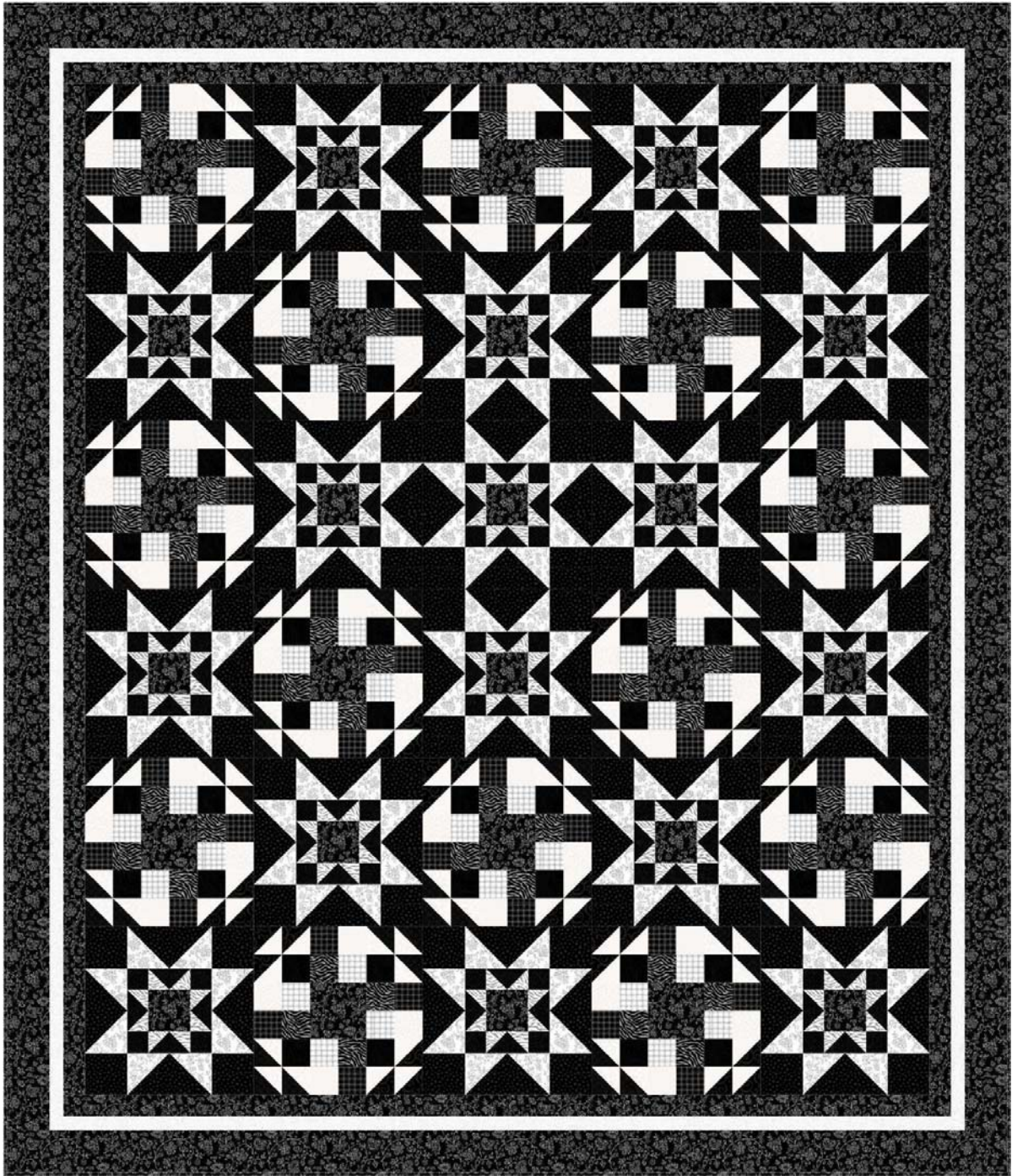

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Finished Size: 71" x 83"

Fabric A- Off White Diamonds 9693-0146 3/8 yard
 Cut (3) 2 7/8" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into (42) 2 7/8" squares.

Fabric B- Black Swirls 9694-0112 3/8 yard
 Cut (3) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (42) 2 7/8" squares.

Fabric C- Off White Swirls 9694 -0146 3/8 yard
 Cut (3) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (42) 2 7/8" squares.

Fabric D- Black Diamonds 9693-0146 3/8 yard
 Cut (3) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (42) 2 7/8" squares.

Fabric E- Black Zebra 9699-0712 3/8 yard
 Cut (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (56) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric F- Black Check 9695-0712 3/8 yard
 Cut (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (56) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric G- Off White Swirl Dot 9686-0146 1/4 yard
 Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (28) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric H- Black Swirl Dot 9686-0112 3/8 yard
 Cut (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (56) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric I- White Check 9698-0146 3/8 yard
 Cut (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (56) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric J- Off White Dot 9698-0146 1/4 yard
 Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (28) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric K- Black Floral 9689-0712 2 1/4 yards
 Cut (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (14) 4 1/2" squares.
 Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 3 1/2" squares.
 Cut (7) 2" strips x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end (with diagonal piecing) and sub- cut into (2) 2" x 72 1/2" inner side borders strips and (2) 2" x 63 1/2" inner top and bottom border strips.
 Cut (8) 3 1/2" strips x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end (with diagonal piecing) and sub- cut into (2) 3 1/2" x 77 1/2" outer side borders strips and (2) 3 1/2" x 71 1/2" outer top and bottom border strips.
 Cut (8) 2 1/4" x WOF strips for double fold binding.

Fabric L- Small Black Dot 9696-0712 1/2 yard
 Cut (2) 4 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 4 1/4" squares. Sub-cut the squares diagonally x 2 into (64) quarter square triangles (QST).
 Cut (4) 2" strips x WOF. Sub-cut the strips into (64) 2" squares.

Fabric M- White Zebra 9699-0746 3/8 yard
 Cut (4) 2 3/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (64) 2 3/8" squares. Sub-cut the squares diagonally x 1 into (128) half square triangles (HST).

Fabric N- Black Dots **9698-0112** **1 1/2 yards**
 Cut (4) 7 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (16) 7 1/4" squares. Sub-cut the squares diagonally x 2 into (64) quarter square triangles (QST).
 Cut (6) 3 1/2" x WOF strips, Sub-cut into (64) 3 1/2" squares.

Fabric O- White Floral **9689-0746** **7/8 yard**
 Cut (7) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (64) 3 7/8" squares. Sub-cut the squares diagonally x 1 into (128) half square triangles (HST).

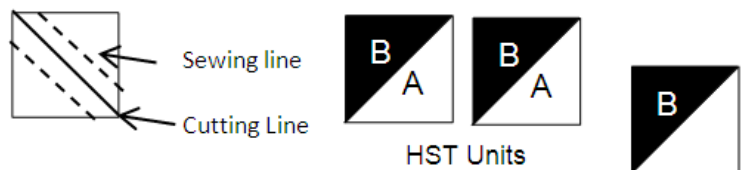
Fabric P- Small White Dot **9696-0746** **3/8 yard**
 Cut (7) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end (with diagonal piecing) and sub- cut into (2) 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" middle side borders strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 65 1/2" middle top and bottom border strips.

Backing- White Floral **9689 -0746** **5 1/8 yards**
 Cut (2) 91" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to a backing 79" x 91".

All seams are sewn right sides together with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise specified.

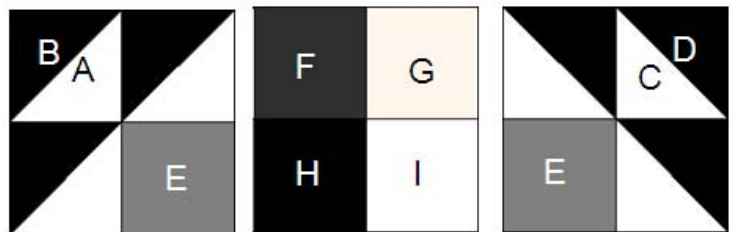
Block 1 — Refer to the Block 1 Assembly Diagram

1. Layer a 2 7/8" fabric A square rights sides together with a 2 7/8" fabric B square. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the lighter square. Sew 1/4" away from the line on both sides. Trim along the line. (fig.1) You will have 2 Half Square Triangle (HST) units measuring 2 1/2" square. Repeat to make (84) A/B HST units.



2. Repeat Step 1 to make (84) HST units using the 2 7/8" fabric C and fabric D squares.

3. Sew 2 A/B HST units together. Sew a 2 1/2" fabric E square to a A/B HST unit. Sew the 2 sections together to make a corner 4 patch unit. Repeat to make (28) A/B corner units.



4. Repeat step 3 with the C/D HST units and fabric E squares. Make (28) C/D corner units.

5. Sew a 2 1/2" fabric F square to a 2 1/2" fabric G square. Sew a 2 1/2" fabric H square to 2 1/2" fabric I square. Sew the sections together to make a 4 patch unit. Repeat to make (28) fabric G 4 patch units.



6. Repeat step 5 using the 2 1/2" fabric J squares instead of the fabric G squares. Make (28) fabric J 4 patch units.

7. Sew the fabric J 4 patch units to each side of a 4 1/2" fabric K center square.

8. Sew a A/B corner unit to one side of a fabric G 4 patch unit. Sew a C/D corner unit to the other side. Make 2 rows.



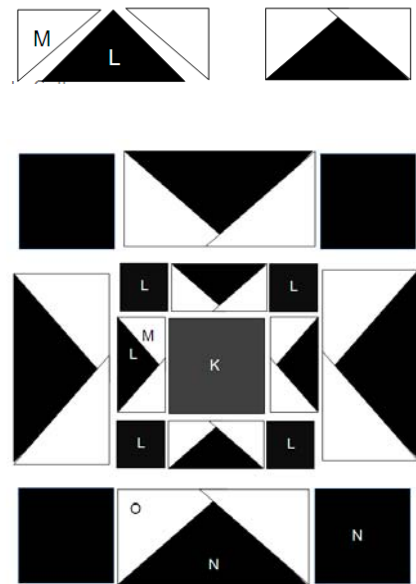
Sew the rows from step 8 to the top and bottom of the center row. Repeat to make a total of (14) 12 1/2" blocks.

Block 2 — *Refer to the Block 2 Assembly Diagram*

1. Sew a 2 3/8" fabric M HST to each side of a 4 1/4" fabric L QST. (fig. 2) Make (64) L/M flying geese units.
2. Sew a L/M flying geese unit to each side of a 3 1/2" fabric K center square.
3. Sew a 2" fabric L square to each side of a L/M flying geese unit. Make 2 rows. Sew the rows to the top and bottom of the center row. Repeat to make (16) 6 1/2" small stars sections.
4. Repeat step 1 using the 3 7/8" fabric O HST triangles and the 7 1/4" fabric N QST to make (64) N/O flying geese units.
5. Sew a N/O flying geese unit to each side of the small star section. Sew a 3 1/2" fabric N square to each side of a N/O flying geese unit. Make 2 rows. Sew a row to the top and bottom of the center section. Repeat to make (16) 12 1/2" star blocks.

Quilt Assembly — *Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram*

1. Sew (3) of block 1 and (2) of block 2 together to make Row 1. Repeat to make Row 5.
2. Sew (3) of block 2 and (2) of block 1 together to make Row 2. Repeat to make Rows 4 and 6.
3. Sew (2) of block 1 and (3) of block 2 together to make Row 3. Watch placement of block 2.
4. Sew all the rows together.
5. Sew a 2" x 72 1/2" fabric K border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew the 2" x 63 1/2" fabric K border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
6. Sew a 1 1/2" x 75 1/2" fabric P border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew the 1 1/2" x 65 1/2" fabric P border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
7. Sew a 3 1/2" x 77 1/2" fabric K border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew the 3 1/2" x 71 1/2" fabric K borders strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. The quilt top should measure 71 1/2" x 83 1/2".
8. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind using the 2 1/4" fabric K binding strips.
