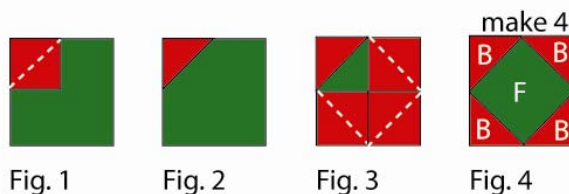

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Fabric A- Panel – Multi	0434-0755	1 panel
Fussy cut one panel, approximately 22 ½" x 34 ½".		
Fabric B- Vines – Red	0438-0142	7/8 yard
Cut two 2 ½" x 34 ½" width of fabric (WOF) strips.		
Cut two 2 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.		
Cut four 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips and two 2 ½" x 36 ½" strips.		
Cut two 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 3 ½" squares.		
Fabric C- Vines – Gold	0438-0191	1/4 yard
Cut two 1" x 37 ½" WOF strips.		
Cut two 1" x 26 ½" WOF strips.		
Fabric D- Dots – Dk. Green	0437-0755	1 yard
Cut two 3 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.		
Cut two 3 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.		
Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.		
Fabric E- Poinsettia – Cream	0435-0730	1 yard
Cut three 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 6 ½" x 48 ½" strips.		
Cut two 6 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.		
Fabric F- Poinsettia – Green	0435-0755	1/4 yard
Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 ½" squares.		
Backing- Pinecones – White	0436-0755	3 1/4 yards
Cut two 56" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 56" x 68" back.		

Block Assembly

1. Sew one 2 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew one 2 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 25 ½" x 37 ½" to make the center block.
2. Place one 3 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of one 6 ½" Fabric F square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
3. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric F square to make one corner block (Fig. 4).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make four corner blocks total.

Quilt Assembly (*refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top*)

5. Sew one 1" x 37 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the center block. Sew one 1" x 26 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block.
6. Sew one 3 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3 1/2" x 32 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block.
7. Sew one 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the center block. Sew one 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block to make the quilt top.
8. Sew one 6 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one corner block to each end of one 6 1/2" x 36 1/2" Fabric E strip to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the six 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
11. Bind as desired.
