FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Finished Size: 34" x 38"

<u>Fabric</u>	<u>Bright Palette</u>	<u>Soft Palette</u>	
Fabric A- Animals Cut one 16 ½" x 20 ½" strip.	0906-0214	0906-0250	½ yard
Fabric B- Mottled Texture #1 Cut one 2" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 2" x 20 ½" strips. Cut one 2" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 2" x 16 ½" strips. Cut one 3 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 3 ½" squares and four 2" squares. Cut four 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.	0910-0228	0910-0226	¾ yard
Fabric C- Zig Zag Cut two 3 ½" x 32 ½" strips from LOF.	0909-0214	0909-0250	1 yard
Fabric D- Diamonds Cut two 3 ½" x 28 ½" strips from WOF.	0907-0214	0907-0250	¼ yard
Fabric E- Circles Cut two 3 ½" x 23 ½" strips. Cut one 3 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 3 ½" x 19 ½" strips.	0908-0214	0908-0250	½ yard
Fabric F- Mottled Texture #2 Cut one 3 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 3 ½" squares and four 2" squares. Cut two 2" x 29 ½" strips. Cut two 2" x 25 ½" strips.	0910-0214	0910-0250	½ yard
Backing Cut one 46" x 42" strip for the back.	your choice	your choice	1½ yards

Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the quilt layout diagram on Page 3)

1. Sew one 2" x 20 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 16 ½" x 20 ½" Fabric A panel.
2. Sew one 2" Fabric F square to each end of one 2" x 16 ½" Fabric B strip. Repeat to make a second strip.
Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the quilt center.
3. Sew one 3 ½" x 23 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt center.
4. Sew one 3 ½" Fabric B square to each end of one 3 ½" x 19 ½" Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip.
Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
5. Sew one 2" x 29 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt center.
6. Sew one 2" Fabric B square to each end of one 2" x 25 ½" Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip.
Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
7. Sew one 3 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the quilt top.
8. Sew one 3 ½" Fabric F square to each end of one 3 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip.
Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew four 2 ½" x 42" Fabric B strips together, end-to-end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
11. Bind as desired.
