Finished Quilt Approximately: 82" x 98" - Finished Block Size: 8" x 8"

Fabric Requirements: Based on 42" wide fabric
2-5/8 yards Fabric A (circular floral #9566-0150)
7/8 yard Fabric B (geometric #9567-0150)
1/4 yard Fabric C (floral #9568-0147)
3/8 yard Fabric D (dots #9569-0150)
1/4 yard Fabric E (circular floral #9570-0122)
1-1/2 yards Fabric F (blue #9571-0122)
1-1/2 yards Fabric G (yellow #9571-0133)
1-7/8 yards Fabric H (charcoal #9571-0140)
7/8 yard Fabric I (green #9571-0156)
7-1/2 yards fabric for backing (#9566-0150 suggested)
90" x 106" quilt batting

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance

From the Fabric A fabric:

Cut five 8-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twenty 8-1/2" squares
Cut eight 5-1/2" x 42" strips for border

From the Fabric B fabric:

Cut three 8-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twelve 8-1/2" squares

From the Fabric C fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 42" strips

From the Fabric D fabric:

Cut two 4-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into sixteen 4-1/2" squares

From the Fabric E fabric:

Cut two 2-1/2" x 42" strips

From the Fabric F fabric:

Cut three 6-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into forty-six 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"
Cut nine 2-1/2" x 42" strips for border, recut one into two equal lengths
Cut two 2-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into thirty-two 2-1/2" squares

From the Fabric G fabric:

Cut eight 2-1/2" x 42" strips for border
Cut eleven 2-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into thirty-eight 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" and
fifty-six 2-1/2" squares

From the Fabric H fabric:

Cut six 2-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into twenty-four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips and
twenty-four 2-1/2" squares
Cut eighteen 2-1/2" x 42" strips for border and binding, recut one into two equal lengths

From the Fabric I fabric:

Cut one 6-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into sixteen 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"
Cut seven 2-1/2" x 42" strips for border, recut one into two equal lengths
Cut one 2-1/2" x 42" strips, recut into sixteen 2-1/2" squares

Block Construction:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the 2-1/2" squares.

2. Lay four Fabric G 2-1/2" squares right sides together on the four corners of an 8-1/2" Fabric A square. Stitch along marked lines. Trim excess to a 1/4" seam allowance. Press triangles out. Make a total of two Fabric G/A Snowball blocks. DIAGRAM 1



3. Make the following number of each Snowball Block using Fabrics A 8-1/2" squares and Fabric G and H 2-1/2" squares. DIAGRAM 2



4. Make the following number of each Snowball Blocks using Fabrics B 8-1/2" squares and Fabric F and I 2-1/2" squares. DIAGRAM 3



5. Stitch a 2-1/2" x 42" Fabric C strip right sides together the length of a Fabric E strip. Press seam to one side. Make a second pieced strip. From these strips cut thirty 2-1/2" slices. DIAGRAM 4



6. Combine the Fabric C/E slices together into fifteen four-patch units. DIAGRAM 5

7. Partially, stitch a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top of a four-patch, only to the Fabric E square. DIAGRAM 6

8. Sew a Fabric F 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to the right side of the four-patch. DIAGRAM 7


9. Stitch a Fabric H 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to the bottom of the four-patch, then a Fabric F 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to the left side of the four-patch. DIAGRAM 8

10. Finish sewing the Fabric G strip to the top edge of the four-patch. Make a total of four of these Framed Four-Patch Blocks. DIAGRAM 9

11. Make the following number of each Framed Four-Patch Blocks using Fabric F, G, H and I 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips as shown. DIAGRAM 10



12. Make the following framed blocks with Fabric D 4-1/2" square centers and Fabric F, G, H and I 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips as shown. DIAGRAM 11





Assembly:

1. Referring to the quilt graphic, lay out the blocks in nine horizontal blocks of seven blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows. Sew rows together.

2. Make two borders each with two 2-1/2" x 42" Fabric I strips. Sew these to the right and left sides of the quilt center. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Make two borders with one whole and one half-length Fabric I 2-1/2" strips. Add these to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

3. Add borders in the following order using the number of whole and half-length strips indicated:

2nd Border - 2-1/2" Fabric G borders - four borders each made with two whole strips

3rd Border - 5-1/2" Fabric A borders - four borders each made with two whole strips

4th Border - 2-1/2" Fabric F borders - side borders each made with two whole and one half-length strips and top and bottom borders made with two full-length strips.

5th Border - 2-1/2" Fabric H borders - side borders each made with two whole and one half-length strips and top and bottom borders made with two full-length strips.

Finishing:

1. Cut backing into three equal lengths. Sew the lengths together along selvage edges to create a three width wide panel. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from nine 2-1/2" x 44" Fabric H strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
