FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Quilt Size – 69" x 80"

Fabric A – Red/Teal Vines 0488-0111 3/8 yard

- Cut two 4 1/2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twelve 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric B – Red Dots 0489-0111 1/2 yard

- Cut three 3 3/4" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 3 3/4" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make forty-eight medium triangles.

Fabric C – Red/Brown Vines 0485-0113 3/4 yard

- Cut three 5" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 5" squares. Cut squares across one diagonal to make forty-eight large triangles.
- Cut two 2 7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 2 7/8" squares. Cut squares across one diagonal to make forty-eight small triangles.

Fabric D – Cream Flowers 0486-0190 1 yard

- Cut twelve 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into (192) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric E – Yellow Flowers 0491-0132 2/3 yard

- Cut six 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into ninety-six 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric F – Teal/Red Flowers 0485-0144 1 yard

- Cut six 4 1/2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into ninety-six 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Fabric G – Dark Teal Print 0483-0111 2/3 yard

- Cut three 4 1/2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into forty-eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Fabric H – Brown Dot 0489-0113 1/2 yard

- Cut four 2 7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into forty-eight 2 7/8" squares.
- Cut the squares across one diagonal to make ninety-six small triangles.

Fabric I – Red Branches 0487-0111 1/2 yard

- Cut three 3 3/4" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 3 3/4" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make forty-eight medium triangles.

Fabric J – Yellow Stripe 0482-0142 3/4 yard

- Cut three 3 1/2" x 42" strips. Piece together to make two 3 1/2" x 58" strips.
- Cut three 3 1/2" x 42" strips. Piece together to make two 3 1/2" x 49 5/8" strips.

Fabric K – Black Floral 0490-0193 1 1/8 yards

- Cut four 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Piece together to make two 2 1/2" x 64" strips.
- Cut three 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Piece together to make two 2 1/2" x 53 5/8" strips.
- Cut eight 2 1/2" x 42" strips for the binding.

Fabric L – Red Stripe 0481-0111 2 1/3 yards

- Cut two 8 1/2" x 84" strips from the length of the fabric for the outer border.
- Cut two 8 1/2" x 73" strips from the length of the fabric for the outer border.

Backing – Brown Floral 0491-0113 5 yards

- Cut two 88" x 42" strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make one 78" x 88" backing piece.

Block Assembly

Sew one Fabric B medium triangle to each side of one 4 ½" Fabric A square to complete one Block Center (Fig. 1).

Sew one Fabric C large triangle to each side of the Block Center (Fig. 2).

Repeat Steps 1-2 to make twelve Block Centers total.

Place one 2 ½" Fabric D square on the left side of one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

Place another 2 ½" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. This completes one D/G/D unit.

Repeat Steps 4-5 to make forty-eight D/G/D units total.

Repeat Steps 4-5 using forty-eight 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric F strips, forty-eight 2 ½" Fabric D squares and forty-eight 2 ½" Fabric E squares to make forty-eight D/F/E units total.

Repeat Steps 4-5 using forty eight 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric F strips, forty-eight 2 ½" Fabric E squares and forty-eight 2 ½" Fabric D squares to make forty-eight E/F/D units total.

Follow Figure 9 to sew together twenty-four D/F/E units, twenty-four E/F/D units, twenty-four D/G/D unit, forty-eight Fabric H small triangles and twenty-four Fabric I medium triangles to complete twenty-four small corner units.

Follow Figure 10 to sew together twenty-four D/F/E units, twenty-four E/F/D units, forty-eight Fabric C small triangles, twenty-four D/G/D unit, forty-eight Fabric H small triangles and twenty-four Fabric I medium triangles to complete twenty-four large corner units.

Follow Figure 11 to sew together one Block Center, two small corner units and two large corner units to make one Block Square.

Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top)

Sew three Block Squares together to make one row. Repeat to make four rows.

Sew the four rows together to complete the quilt top.

Sew one 3 ½" x 58" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3 ½" x 49 5/8" Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Sew one 2 ½" x 64" Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 ½" x 53 5/8" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Center one 8 ½" x 84" Fabric L strip on one side of the quilt top and pin in place.

Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with opposite side.

Repeat Step 16 to sew one 8 ½" x 73" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 12).

Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Fig. 12), draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

Layer and quilt as desired.

Sew the eight 2 ½" x 42" Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.

Bind as desired.
