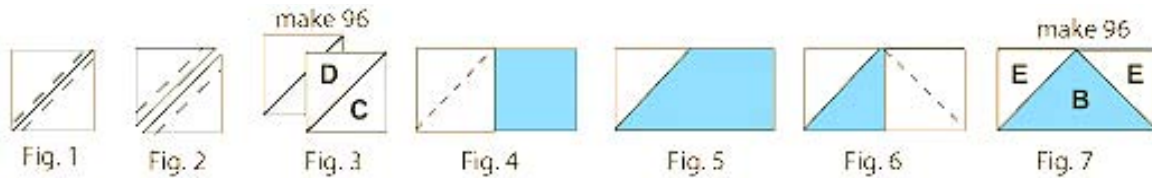
FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Fabric A- Large Blue Flowers	0314-0150	5/8 yard
• Cut three 4 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 4 ½" squares.		
Fabric B- Blue Tonal Flowers	0319-0150	1-2/3 yards
• Cut seven 4 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into four 4 ½" squares and ninety-six 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.		
• Cut eight 2 ½" x 42" strips for the binding.		
Fabric C- Teal Leaves	0318-0150	½ yard
• Cut four 2-7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into forty-eight 2-7/8" squares.		
Fabric D- Tan Daisies	0316-0142	½ yard
• Cut four 2-7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into forty-eight 2-7/8" squares.		
Fabric E- Cream Tonal Flowers	0319-0142	1 ¾ yards
• Cut six 4 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into ninety-six 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.		
• Cut thirteen 2 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into (192) 2 ½" squares.		
Fabric F- Red and Cream Floral	0311-0129	½ yard
• Cut four 2-7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into forty-eight 2-7/8" squares.		
Fabric G- Tan and Red Bouquet	0312-0129	5/8 yard
• Cut three 4 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty-four 4 ½" squares.		
Fabric H- Red Tonal Flowers	0319-0129	1-1/8 yards
• Cut thirteen 2 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into (192) 2 ½" squares.		
Fabric I- Red Buds	0315-0129	½ yard
• Cut four 2-7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into forty-eight 2-7/8" squares.		
Fabric J- Dark Teal Stars	0332-0150	2/3 yard
• Cut seven 2 ½" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips and two 2 ½" x 52 ½" strips for the inner borders.		
Fabric K- Tan Stripe	0313-0150	1-1/8 yards
• Cut seven 4 ½" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two 4 ½" x 68 ½" and two 4 ½" x 52 ½" strips.		
Backing- Green Buds	0315-0114	5 yards
• Cut two 84" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make one 68" x 84" backing.		

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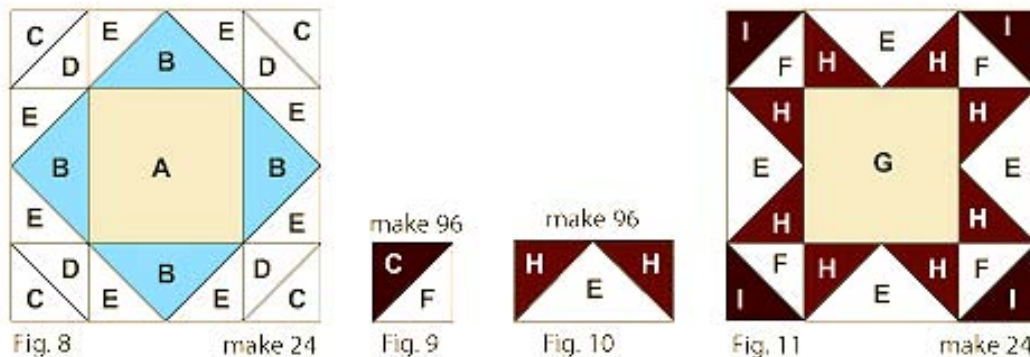
Block Assembly

- Place one 2-7/8" Fabric C square on top of one 2-7/8" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two C/D units (Fig. 3). Trim the units to 2 1/2" square. Repeat to make ninety-six 2 1/2" C/D units.
- Place one 2 1/2" Fabric E square on the left side of one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from the behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Place another 2 1/2" Fabric E square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to complete one E/B/E unit. Repeat to make ninety-six E/B/E units.



- Follow Figure 8 to sew together four E/B/E units, four C/D units and one 4 1/2" Fabric A square to make one 8 1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make twenty-four Block One squares
- Repeat Step 1 using forty-eight 2-7/8" Fabric F squares and forty-eight 2-7/8" Fabric I squares to make ninety-six 2 1/2" F/I units (Fig. 9).
- Repeat Steps 2-3 using ninety-six 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric E strips and (192) 2 1/2" Fabric H squares to make ninety-six H/E/H units (Fig. 10).
- Follow Figure 11 to sew together four H/E/H units, four F/I units and one 4 1/2" Fabric G square to make one 8 1/2" Block Two Square. Repeat to make twenty-four Block Two Squares.

Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew three Block One squares and three Block Two squares together, alternating them to make Row 1. Repeat to make Rows 3, 5 and 7.
9. Sew three Block Two squares and three Block One squares together, alternating them to make Row 2. Repeat to make Rows 4, 6 and 8
10. Sew the rows together in numerical order to complete the 48 ½" x 64 ½" quilt top.
11. Sew one 2 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
12. Sew one 4 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top.
13. Sew one 4 ½" Fabric B square to each of one 4 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric K strip and sew this strip to the top of the quilt top. Repeat to make and sew a second strip to the bottom of the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the eight 2 ½" x 42" Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
16. Bind as desired.
