## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Quilt Size- 56" x 56"

<b>Fabric A- Who's Watching Panel</b>	<b>0510-0112</b>	<b>1 Panel</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut the large panel approximately 17 ½" x 19 ½"</li> <li>• Cut six small panels approximately 4 ½" x 4 ½"</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric B- Cats and Swirls</b>	<b>0511-0128</b>	<b>1/3 yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut one 8 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into two 8 ½" squares.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric C- Black Eyes</b>	<b>0514-0112</b>	<b>1 yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut one 2" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into two 2" x 20 ½" strips.</li> <li>• Cut three 2 ½" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twelve 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.</li> <li>• Cut two 2" x 19 ½" strips from the length of fabric (LOF).</li> <li>• Cut twelve 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips from the LOF.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric D- Orange Dots</b>	<b>0517-0128</b>	<b>1/3 yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut two 3-7/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into sixteen 3 7/8" squares.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric E- Green</b>	<b>0516-0114</b>	<b>5/8 yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut one 8 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into sixteen 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.</li> <li>• Cut one 6 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into sixteen 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric F- Black Dots</b>	<b>0517-0112</b>	<b>¾ yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut one 3-7/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into eight 3-7/8" squares.</li> <li>• Cut six 2 ½" x 42" strips for the binding.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric G- Black Webs</b>	<b>0515-0112</b>	<b>5/8 yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut six 2 ½" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2 ½" x 42 ½" strips and two 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric H- Purple</b>	<b>0516-0135</b>	<b>½ yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut two 2 ½" x 22 ½" strips.</li> <li>• Cut two 1 ½" x 24 ½" strips.</li> <li>• Cut two 1 ½" x 42 ½" strips.</li> <li>• Cut two 1 ½" x 40 ½" strips.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric I- Multi Stripe</b>	<b>0512-0135</b>	<b>¼ yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut one 3-7/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into eight 3-7/8" squares.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric J- Yellow Pumpkins</b>	<b>0513-0133</b>	<b>1 ¼ yards</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut six 5 ½" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make four 5 ½" x 46 ½" strips.</li> </ul>		
<b>Fabric K- Black Pumpkins</b>	<b>0513-0112</b>	<b>¼ yard</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut one 5 ½" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into four 5 ½" squares.</li> </ul>		
<b>Backing- Black Pumpkins</b>	<b>0513-0112</b>	<b>3 ¾ yards</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut two 62" x 42 Strips. Sew and trim to make one 64" x 64" backing.</li> </ul>

### Block Assembly Instructions

1) Sew one 2" x 19 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the 17 1/2" x 19 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew one 2" x 20 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A panel (Fig. 1).

2) Sew one 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the center panel. Sew one 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the center panel (Fig. 2).

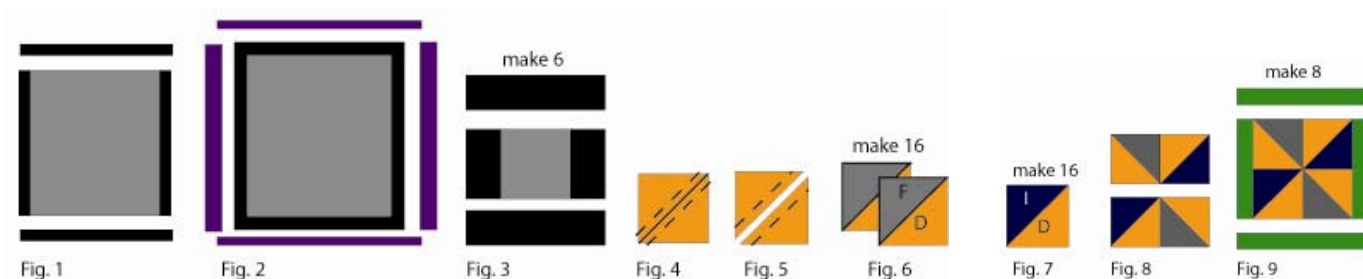
3) Sew one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of one 4 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. This completes one 8 1/2" Block One (Fig. 3). Repeat to make six Block Ones.

4) Place one 3 7/8" Fabric D square on top one 3 7/8" Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 4). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5) to make two D/F half-square triangles (Fig. 6). Trim the blocks to measure 3 1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of sixteen D/F half-square triangles.

5) Repeat Step 4, using eight 3 7/8" Fabric D squares and eight 3 7/8" Fabric I squares to make sixteen D/I 3 1/2" half-square triangles (Fig. 7).

6) Sew two D/F and two D/I half-square triangles together, alternating them, to make one 6 1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of eight 6 1/2" squares (Fig. 8).

7) Sew one 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the 6 1/2" square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the square. This completes one 8 1/2" Block Two (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a total of eight 8 1/2" Block Twos.



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**Quilt Top Assembly Instructions- *Refer to the quilt layout while assembling.***

8) Sew one Block Two to the top and bottom of one 8 ½" Fabric B square. Sew this strip to the left side of the center block. Repeat to make the right side border and sew it to the right side of the center block.

9) Sew three Block Ones and two Block Twos together, alternating them, to make the top row. Sew this strip to the top of the center block. Repeat to make the bottom border and sew it to the bottom of the center block to complete the 40 ½" x 40 ½" quilt top.

10) Sew one 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

11) Sew one 2 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

12) Sew one 5 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt.

13) Sew one 5 ½" Fabric K square to each end of the remaining two 5 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric J strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

14) Layer and quilt as desired.

15) Sew the six 2-1/2 x 42" Fabric F strips together end -to-end with 45° seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16) Bind as desired.
