

# The Wool Collection

## "Acorns in Every Color"

### You'll Need:

- 3" squares of assorted colors from the Wool Collection
- Acorn caps, 3/4" in diameter or larger  
(if you cannot harvest the acorn caps locally,  
order online through ETSY or Ebay)
- Strong thread (buttonhole twist)
- Hand sewing needle
- Fiberfill
- E6000 Glue



### Instructions:

1. Begin by cutting circles from the wool. I used a 2" circle for acorn caps with a 3/4" diameter, 2 1/4" circle for acorn caps with a 1" diameter, and a 2 1/4" circle for acorn caps with a 1 1/4" diameter.
1. Using strong thread, make a running stitch around the perimeter of each circle 1/8" from the edge. (Remember to secure the beginning knot.)
2. Stuff the circle with fiberfill, using an amount that is equal to a cotton ball.
3. Pull the running stitch tight and knot off securely.
4. With the pencil eraser "dust out" your acorn cap if necessary. Place a small amount of the E6000 Glue into the acorn cap. Insert stitched end of stuffed wool circle into the acorn cap, pushing gently around the sides to "seat" it securely. Allow glue to dry completely.. Repeat for the remaining acorn caps.

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
