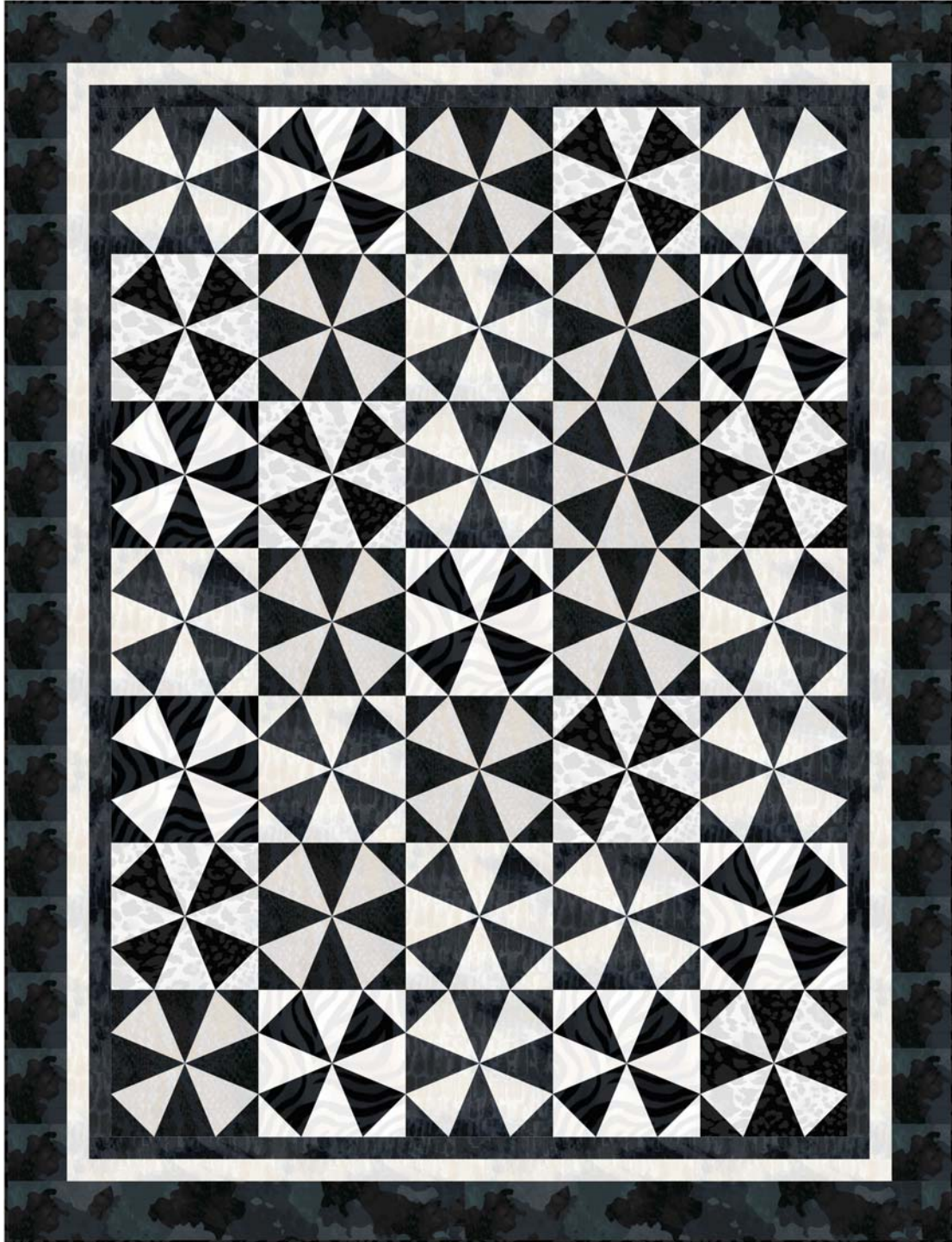

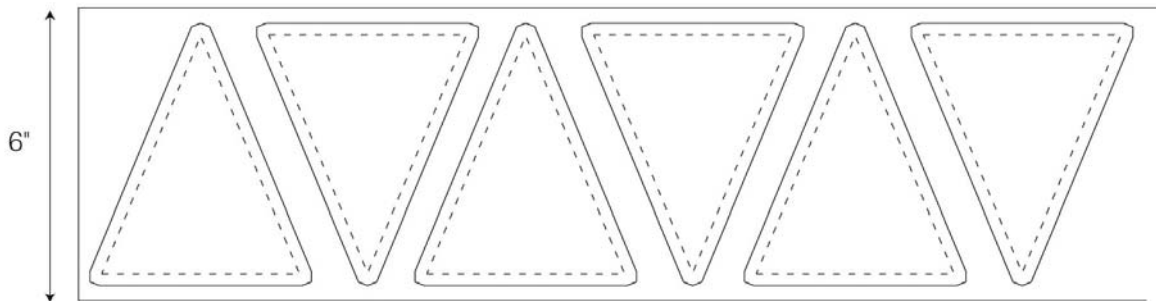

Marcus Fabrics / Incognito Quilt
 Finished quilt size: 64" x 84"
 Finished block size: 10" x 10"
 Backing: 72" x 92" (5 1/4y of 42" wide fabric)

Fabrics and Cutting Chart






Note: cutting illustration for B and C pieces using template.



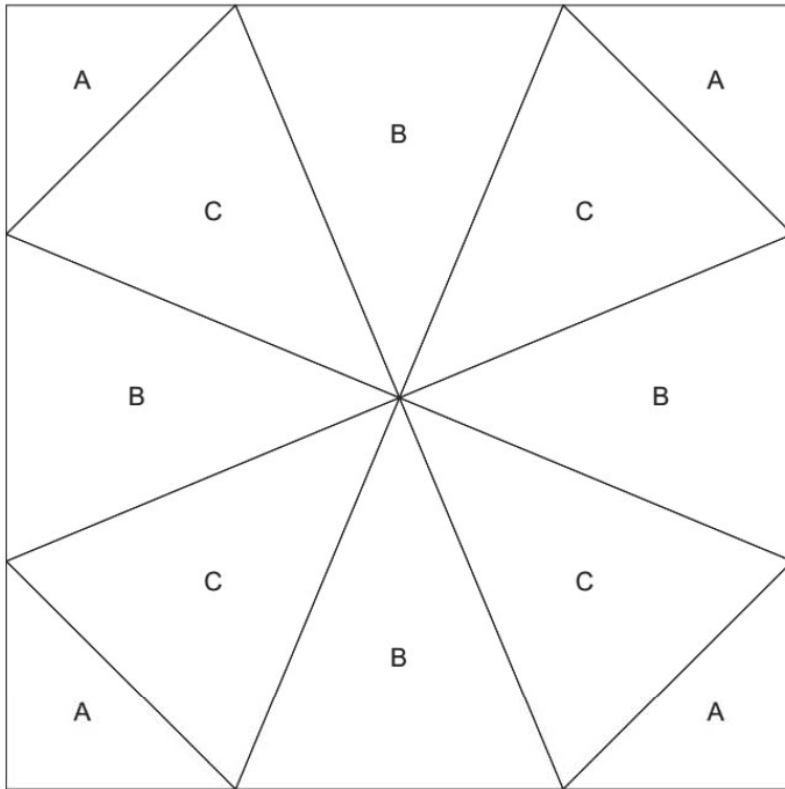
(1) 6" x wof should sufficiently cut (12) B or C pieces.

Fabrics	Yardages	Cutting Directions
 0865-0118 Fabric A	1 1/8y	a. Outer border (8) 4 1/2" x wof. Piece strips and subcut (2) 4 1/2" x 64 1/2" and (2) 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" strips.
 0866-0118 Fabric B	1 3/8y	a. Pieced blocks (24) A, (24) B and (20) C pieces using provided templates. b. Inner border #1 (7) 2" x wof. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2" x 53 1/2" and (2) 2" x 70 1/2" strips.
 0866-0146 Fabric C	1 1/4y	a. Pieced blocks (20) A, (20) B and (24) C pieces using provided templates. b. Inner border #2 (7) 2" x wof. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2" x 56 1/2" and (2) 2" x 73 1/2" strips.
 0867-0118 Fabric D	3/4y	a. Pieced blocks (8) A, (8) B, and (24) C pieces using provided templates.

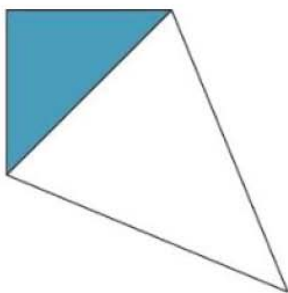
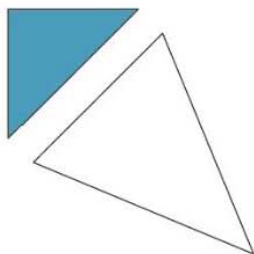

 0867-0146, Fabric E	7/8y	a. Pieced blocks (24) A, (24) B and (12) C pieces using provided templates.
 0868-0118, Fabric F	7/8y	a. Pieced blocks (32) A, (32) B and (4) C pieces using provided templates.
 0868-0146, Fabric G	3/4y	a. Pieced blocks (4) A, (4) B and (32) C pieces using provided templates.
 0869-0118, Fabric H	1 3/8y, includes binding	a. Pieced blocks (8) A, (8) B and (20) C pieces using provided templates. b. Binding (9) 2 1/4" x wof. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.
 0869-0146, Fabric I	5/8y	a. Pieced blocks (20) A, (20) B and (4) C pieced using provided templates.

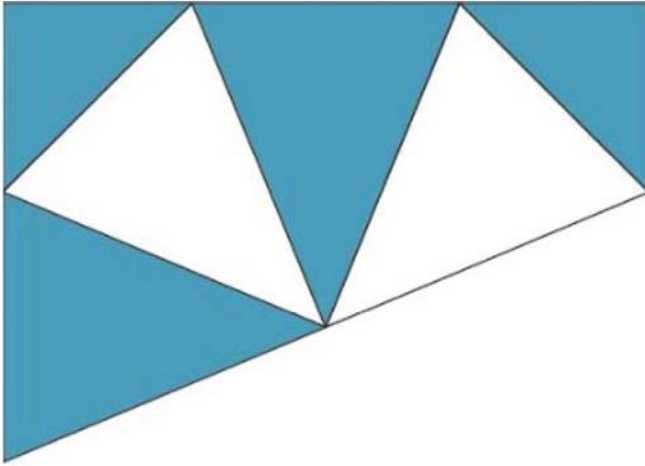
Constructing pieced blocks



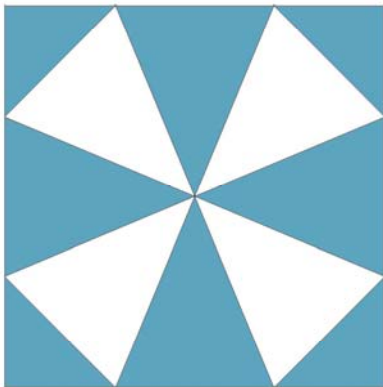
Step 1. Sew together (1) **Fabric 1** A piece and (1) **Fabric 2** C piece to make a pieced unit. Make a total of (4) pieced units.











Step 2. Sew together (2) pieced units and (2) **Fabric 1 B** pieces to make (1) block half, as shown. Make a total of (2) block halves.



Step 3. Sew (2) block halves together to complete (1) pieced block.

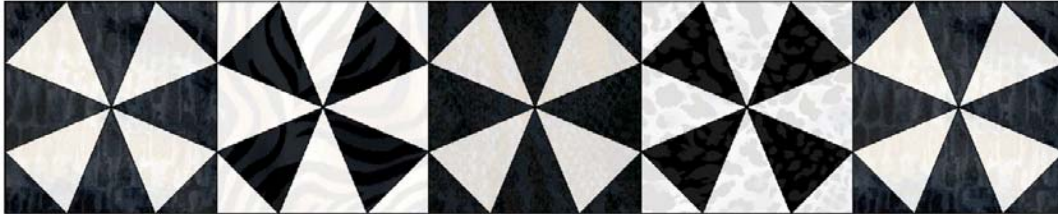


Step 4. Make a total number of blocks in the following **Fabric 1/Fabric 2** combinations:

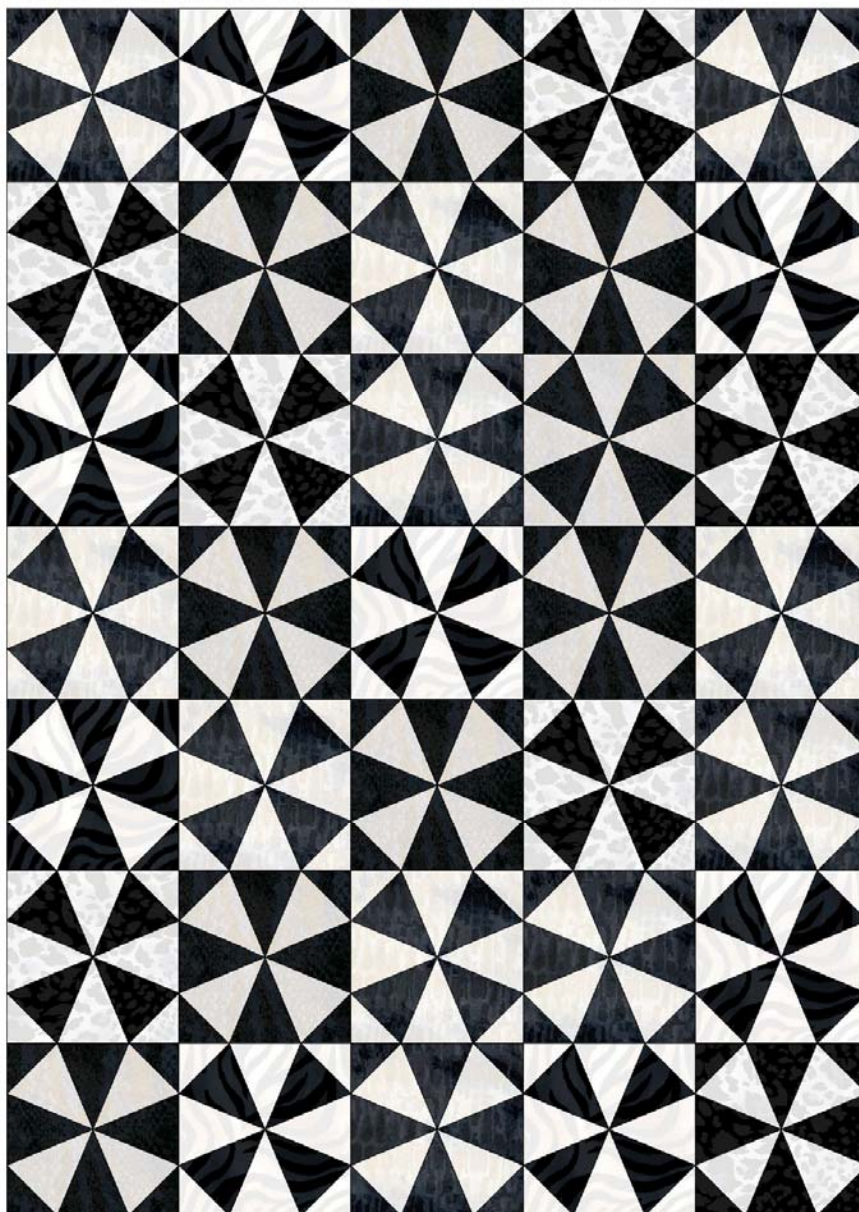

Quilt center assembly

Step 1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (5) pieced blocks to make (1) pieced row. Make a total of (7) pieced rows. Row 1 is shown below.



Step 2. Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center.



Quilt top assembly

Step 1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 2" x 70 1/2" **Fabric B** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x 53 1/2" **Fabric B** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

Step 2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 2" x 73 1/2" **Fabric C** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x 56 1/2" **Fabric C** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Step 3. Outer border. Sew (2) 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" **Fabric A** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 4 1/2" x 64 1/2" **Fabric A** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

**Finishing**

Step 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.

Step 2. Quilt as desired.

Step 3. Bind to finish quilt.
