FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Finished Size: 50" x 59"

Fabric A- Red Vines	0955-0111	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric B- Red Buds	0951-0111	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric C- Black Triangle Buds	0958-0144	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric D- Black Vines	0954-0112	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric E- Cream and Black Vines	0959-0112	1 yard
Cut seven 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighty 3 ½" squares.		
Fabric F- Red Triangle Buds	0958-0111	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric G- Black Dots	0956-0144	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric H- Red Daisies	0953-0111	½ yard
Cut two 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric I- Red Dots	0956-0111	½ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares. Cut one 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" squares.		
Fabric J- Red Lattice	0952-0111	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric K- Red Doodles	0954-0111	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric L- Black Buds	0951-0112	½ yard
Cut two 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric M- Black Grid	0962-0112	1 yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares. Cut six 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy-two 3 ½" squares.		
Fabric N- Black Daisies	0953-0112	1 1/8 yards
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares. Cut three 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 1 ½" x 57 ½" strips. Cut three 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut two 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips. Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.		
Fabric O- Black Lattice	0952-0112	¼ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.		
Fabric P- Black Vines	0955-0144	½ yard
Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares. Cut one 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.		

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Fabric Q- Red Grid

Cut one 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 6 7/8" squares.

Backing- Red Buds

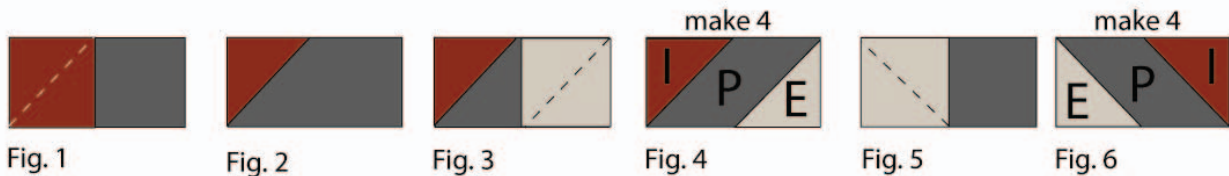

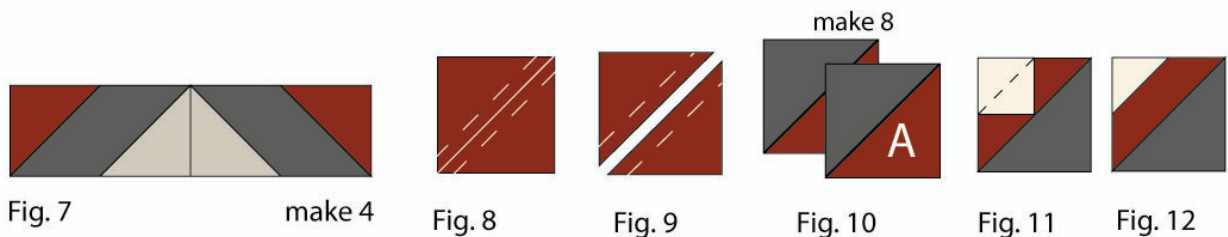
Cut two 58" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make one 58" x 67" back.

Block Assembly

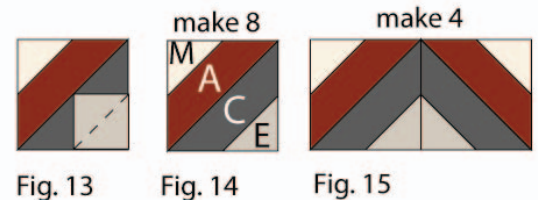
- Place one 3 ½" Fabric I square on the left side of one 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric P strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- Place one 3 ½" Fabric E square on the right side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric P strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to complete one I/P/E unit.
- Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make four I/P/E units total.
- Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to sew one 3 ½" Fabric E square on the left side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric P strip, except this time sew from the upper left to lower right corner (Fig. 5). Repeat to sew a 3 ½" Fabric I square on the right side of the strip to make one E/P/I unit (Fig. 6). Repeat to make four E/P/I units total.



- Sew together one I/P/E unit and one E/P/I unit, lengthwise, to make one Block One unit (Fig. 7). Repeat to make four Block One units total.
- Place one 6 7/8" Fabric A square on top of one 6 7/8" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 8). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9) to make two A/C squares (Fig. 10). Trim the A/C squares to measure 6 ½". Repeat to make eight A/C squares total.
- Place one 3 ½" Fabric M square on the red corner of one A/C square, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 12). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

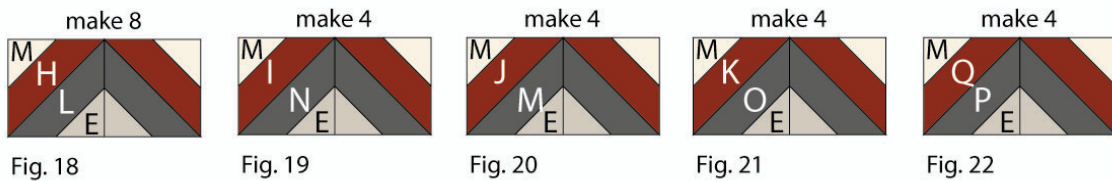
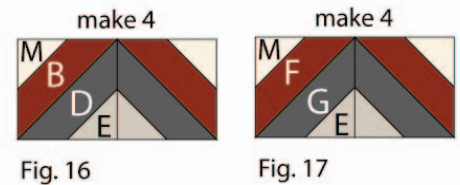


- Place one 3 ½" Fabric E square on the black/gray corner of one A/C square, right sides together (Fig. 13). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 13). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 14). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to complete one M/A/C/E block.
- Repeat Steps 6-8 to make eight M/A/C/E blocks total.
- Sew two M/A/C/E block together to make one Block Two (Fig. 15).
- Repeat Steps 6-8 using eight 3 ½" Fabric M squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric B squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric D squares and eight 3 ½" Fabric E squares to make eight M/B/D/E blocks.

12. Sew two M/B/D/E blocks together to make one Block Three (Fig. 16). Repeat to make four Block Threes total.
13. Repeat Steps 6-8 using eight 3 1/2" Fabric M squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric F squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric G squares and eight 3 1/2" Fabric E squares to make eight M/F/G/E blocks.
14. Sew two M/F/G/E blocks together to make one Block Four (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four Block Fours total.
15. Repeat Steps 6-8 using sixteen 3 1/2" Fabric M squares, eight 6 7/8" Fabric H squares, eight 6 7/8" Fabric L squares and sixteen 3 1/2" Fabric E squares to make sixteen M/H/L/E blocks.
16. Sew two M/H/L/E blocks together to make one Block Five (Fig. 18). Repeat to make eight Block Fives total.
17. Repeat Steps 6-8 using eight 3 1/2" Fabric M squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric I squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric N squares and eight 3 1/2" Fabric E squares to make eight M/I/N/E blocks.
18. Sew two M/I/N/E blocks together to make one Block Six (Fig. 19). Repeat to make four Block Sixes total.
19. Repeat Steps 6-8 using eight 3 1/2" Fabric M squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric J squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric M squares and eight 3 1/2" Fabric E squares to make eight M/J/M/E blocks.
20. Sew two M/J/M/E blocks together to make one Block Seven (Fig. 20). Repeat to make four Block Sevens total.
21. Repeat Steps 6-8 using eight 3 1/2" Fabric M squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric K squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric O squares and eight 3 1/2" Fabric E squares to make eight M/K/O/E blocks.
22. Sew two M/K/O/E blocks together to make one Block Eight (Fig. 21). Repeat to make four Block Eights total.
23. Repeat Steps 6-8 using eight 3 1/2" Fabric M squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric Q squares, four 6 7/8" Fabric P squares and eight 3 1/2" Fabric E squares to make eight M/Q/P/E blocks.
24. Sew two M/Q/P/E blocks together to make one Block Nine (Fig. 22). Repeat to make four Block Nines total.



Quilt Assembly

(Refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top) ►

25. Sew together one of each of the Block One through Block Nine. Sew another Block Five at the bottom of the sewn blocks after Block Nine to make one column. Repeat to make four columns total.
26. Sew the four columns together, flipping column two and four 180°, to make the quilt top.
27. Sew one 1 1/2" x 57 1/2" Fabric N strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric N strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
28. Layer and quilt as desired.
29. Sew the six 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
30. Bind as desired.
