FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Fabric A- Swirls	Yellow 0540-0144	Green 0540-0116	1/4 yard
Cut one 3-7/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into ten 3-7/8" squares. Cut one 2" x 42" strip.			
Fabric B- Leaves	0523-0144	0523-0116	1/4 yard
Cut one 3-7/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into ten 3-7/8" squares. Cut one 2" x 42" strip.			
Fabric C- Little Daisies	0525-0144	0525-0116	1/3 yard
Cut two 3-7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty 3-7/8" squares.			
Fabric D- Double Loops	0526-0144	0525-0116	1/3 yard
Cut two 3-7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into twenty 3-7/8" squares.			
Fabric E- Maze1	0527-0133	0527-0128	1 1/8 yards
Cut one 3-7/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into ten 3-7/8" strips. Cut one 2" x 42" strip. Cut three 2 1/2" x 42" strips. Piece together and cut two 2 1/2" x 45 1/2" strips. Cut two 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips. Cut six 2 1/2" x 42" strips for the binding.			
Fabric F- Maze2	0527-0144	0527-0117	1/4 yard
Cut one 3-7/8" x 42" strip. Sub-cut into ten 3-7/8" squares. Cut one 2" x 42" strip.			
Fabric G- Large Flowers	0539-0144	0539-0116	1 1/8 yards
Cut six 5 1/2" x 42" strips. Piece together and cut two 5 1/2" x 49 1/2" strips and two 5 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.			
Fabric H- White	Plain White	Plain White	1 1/8 yards
Cut eight 3-7/8" x 42" strips. Sub-cut into eighty 3-7/8" squares.			
Backing- Squares	0524-0144	0524-0116	3 1/2 yards
Cut two 58" x 42" Strips. Sew together to make the 58" x 67" back.			

Block assembly

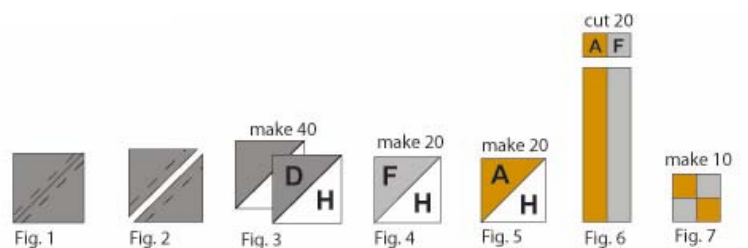
1) Place one 3-7/8" Fabric D square on top one 3-7/8" Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two D/H units (Fig. 3). Trim the units to measure 3 1/2". Repeat to make forty 3 1/2" D/H units total.

2) Repeat Step 1 using ten 3-7/8" Fabric F squares and ten 3-7/8" Fabric H squares to make twenty 3 1/2" F/H units (Fig. 4).

3) Repeat Step 1 using ten 3-7/8" Fabric A squares and ten 3-7/8" Fabric H squares to make twenty 3 1/2" A/H units (Fig. 5).

4) Sew one 2" x 42" Fabric A strip to one 2" x 42" Fabric F strip, lengthwise. Sub-cut this strip into twenty 2" x 3 1/2" A/F units (Fig. 6).

5) Sew two of the A/F units together with like colors opposite from one another to make one 3 1/2" Block One center (Fig. 7). Repeat to make ten Block One centers total.



6) Sew four D/H units, two A/H units, two F/H units and one Block One center together to make 9 1/2" Block One (Fig. 8). Repeat to make ten Block Ones total.

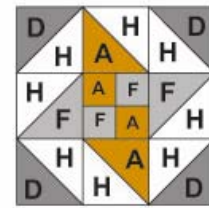


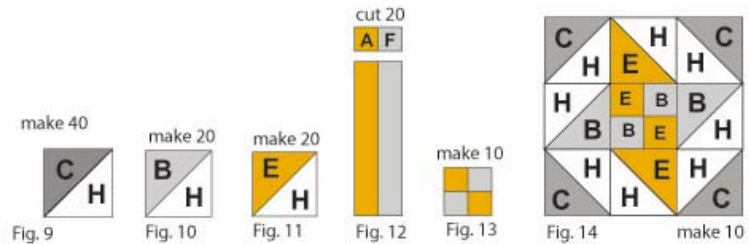

7) Repeat Step 1 using twenty 3-7/8" Fabric C squares and twenty 3-7/8" Fabric H squares to make forty C/H units (Fig. 9).

8) Repeat Step 1 using ten 3-7/8" Fabric B squares and ten 3-7/8" Fabric H squares to make twenty B/H units (Fig. 10).

9) Repeat Step 1 using ten 3-7/8" Fabric E squares and ten 3-7/8" Fabric H squares to make twenty E/H units (Fig. 11).

10) Sew one 2" x 42" Fabric E strip to one 2" x 42" Fabric B strip, lengthwise. Sub-cut this strip into twenty 2" x 3 1/2" E/B units (Fig. 12).



11) Sew two of the E/B units together with like colors opposite from one another to make one 3 1/2" Block Two center (Fig. 13). Repeat to make ten Block Two centers total.

12) Sew four C/H units, two B/H units, two E/H units and one Block Two center to make ten Block Twos (Fig. 14).

Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top.)

13) Sew two Block One squares and two Block Two squares together, alternating them, to make Row 1. Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.

14) Sew two Block Two squares and two Block One squares together, alternating them, to make Row 2. Repeat to make Row Four.

15) Sew the five rows together, in order, to complete the 36 1/2" x 45 1/2" quilt top.

16) Sew one 2 1/2" x 45 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

17) Sew one 5 1/2" x 49 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 5 1/2" x 50 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

18) Layer and quilt as desired.

19) Sew six 2 1/2" x 42" Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.

20) Bind as desired.
