FABRIC REQUIREMENTS & CUTTING GUIDE

Quilt Size: 54" x 66"

Red Version**Fabric A- Plaid – Red****0847-0111****1/4 yard**

Cut one 4 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric B- Tonal – Turkey Red**0695-0155****1/3 yard**

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Fabric C- Crackle – Brown**0826-0113****1 yard**

Cut three 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 4 1/2" squares.

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric D- Tonal Paisley – Cream**0824-0142****1 1/4 yards**

Cut eleven 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (168) 2 1/2" squares.

Cut three 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Fabric E- Packed Paisley – Red**0827-0111****5/8 yard**

Cut four 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric F- Tonal – Pewter**0695-0147****1 yard**

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Cut three 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 1 1/2" x 49 1/2" strips.

Cut two 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" WOF strips.

Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric G- Tossed Paisley – Red**0828-0111****1 yard**

Cut four 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips.

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.

Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut seventy-two 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric H- Large Paisley – Red**0824-0111****1 1/2 yards**

Cut four 6 1/2" x 50 1/2" length of fabric (LOF) strips.

Backing- Large Paisley – Red**0824-0111****3 1/2 yards**

Cut two 62" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 62" x 74" back.

Blue Version**Fabric A- Plaid – Blue****0847-0150****1/4 yard**

Cut one 4 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 4 1/2" squares.

Fabric B- Tonal – Sky**065-0122****1/3 yard**

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Fabric C- Tossed Paisley – Gold**0828-0132****1 yard**

Cut three 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 4 1/2" squares.

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric D- Tonal Paisley – Cream **0824-0142** **1 1/4 yards**

Cut eleven 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (168) 2 ½" squares.
Cut three 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Fabric E- Packed Paisley – Blue **0827-0150** **5/8 yard**

Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty 4 ½" squares.

Fabric F- Tonal – Light Cheddar **0695-0132** **1 yard**

Cut three 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
Cut three 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 1 ½" x 49 ½" strips.
Cut two 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric G- Tossed Paisley – Blue **0828-0150** **1 yard**

Cut four 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 ½" x 62 ½" strips.
Cut three 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut seventy-two 2 ½" squares.

Fabric H- Large Paisley – Blue **0824-0150** **1 1/2 yards**

Cut four 6 ½" x 50 ½" length of fabric (LOF) strips.

Backing- Large Paisley – Blue **0824-0150** **3 1/2 yards**

Cut two 62" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 62" x 74" back.

Block Assembly— Refer to DIAGRAMS on Page 4

(Pay attention to the orientation of the units while assembling the various components.)

- Place one 2 ½" Fabric D square on the top left corner of one 4 ½" Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
- Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add one 2 ½" Fabric D square to the lower right corner of the 4 ½" Fabric E square to make one Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).
- Repeat Steps 1-2 to make twenty-four Unit 1 squares total.
- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make twenty-four Unit 2 squares.
- Place one 2 ½" Fabric D square on the left side of one 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- Place another 2 ½" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make one Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).
- Repeat Steps 5-6 to make twenty-four Unit 3 strips total.
- Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 10-12 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make twenty-four Unit 4 strips, twenty-four Unit 5 strips and twenty-four Unit 6 strips.
- Sew one Unit 3 strip to the top of one Unit 4 strip along the Fabric C sides to make one Unit 7 square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make twenty-four Unit 7 squares total.
- Sew one Unit 5 strip to the top of one Unit 6 strip to make one Unit 7 square (Fig. 13). Note the Unit 5 strip is turned 180°. Repeat to make twenty-four Unit 7 squares total.
- Sew one Unit 1 square to each side of one Unit 7 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 7 square to each side of one 4 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the three rows together to make one Block One square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make six Block One squares total.
- Sew one Unit 2 square to each side of one Unit 8 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew one Unit 8 square to each side of one 4 ½" Fabric E square to make the middle row. Sew the three rows together to make one Block Two square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make six Block Two squares total.

(Pay attention to the orientation of the units while assembling the various components.)

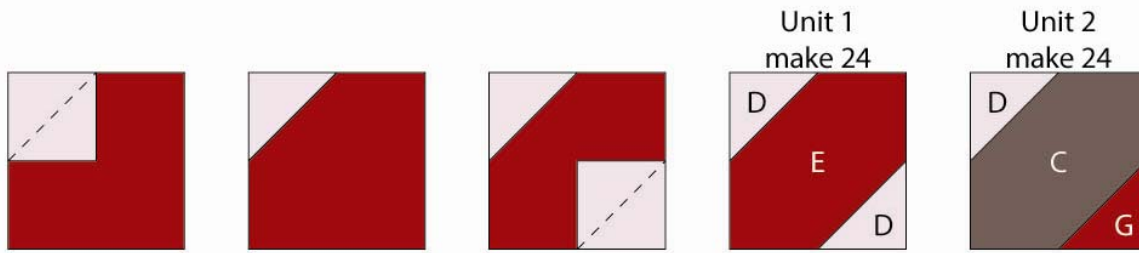

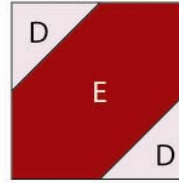

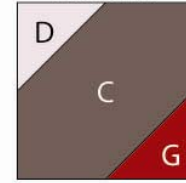

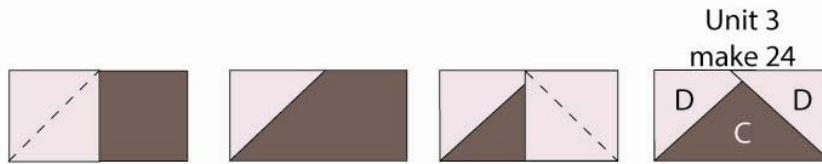

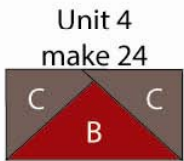

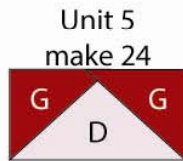

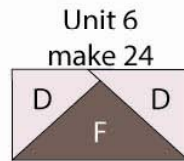

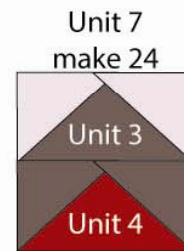

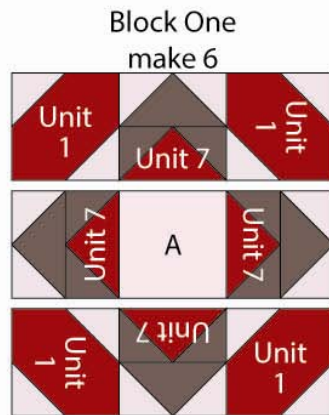

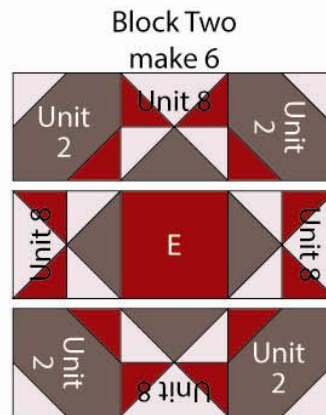

Quilt Assembly (refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top)

13. Sew one Block One square to each side of one Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
14. Sew one Block Two square to each side of one Block One square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
15. Sew the four rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
16. Sew one 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew one 6 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 6 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew one 2 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
21. Bind as desired.
