Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Fabric A- Tonal – Cream R2165-Cream 2 1/4 yards

- Cut fourteen 4 ½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into (126) 4 ½" squares.
- \cdot Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and trim the seams to $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut the strip into two 2" x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and trim the seams to ¼". Cut the strip into two 2" x 59 ½" strips.

Fabric B- Tonal – Tan R2165-Tan 7/8 yard

• Cut fourteen 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (126) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric C- Stripe – Green R2166-Green 7/8 yard

• Cut three 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty 8 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Fabric D- Rings - Aqua R2168-Aqua 7/8 yard

• Cut five 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

Fabric E- Squiggles – Dark Blue R2167-Dark Blue 1 1/8 yards

• Cut eight 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-one 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

Fabric F- Tonal – Red R2165-Red 5/8 yard

• Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

Fabric G- Stripe – Pink R2166-Pink 5/8 yard

• Cut two 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fifteen 8 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Fabric H- Stripe - Medium Blue R2166-Medium Blue 5/8 yard

• Cut two 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 8 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

Fabric I- Squiggles – Dark Green R2167-Dark Green 1/2 yard

• Cut three 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 4 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

Version #1

Fabric J- Paint Swatches – Blue R2164-Blue 1 1/8 yards

- \cdot Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and trim the seams to ¼". Cut the strip into two 4 ½" x 75 ½" strips.
- \cdot Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and trim the seams to ¼". Cut the strip into two 4 ½" x 67 ½" strips.

Version #2

Fabric J- Paint Swatches – Multi R2164-Multi 1 1/8 yards

- Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and trim the seams to ¼". Cut the strip into two 4 ½" x 75 ½" strips.
- Cut four 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and trim the seams to ¼". Cut the strip into two 4 ½" x 67 ½" strips.

Fabric K- Tonal – Navy R2165-Navy 2/3 yard

• Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing- Rings – Beige R2168-Beige 5 1/8 yards

• Cut two 91" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 75" x 91" back.

Block Assembly — REFER to ILLUSTRATION on PAGE 4

Pay attention to the orientation of the units while assembling the various components.

- 1) Place one 4 ½" Fabric B square on the top half of one 4 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together and aligning the tops of the fabrics (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- 2) Place another 4 ½" Fabric B square on the bottom half of the 4 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together aligning the bottoms of the fabrics (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¾" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
- 3) Repeat Steps 1-2 to make twenty Unit 1 strips total.
- 4) Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 5-7 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make fifteen Unit 2 strips, sixteen Unit 3 strips and twelve Unit 4 strips.
- 5) Place one 4 ½" Fabric A square on the top half of one 4 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip, right sides together and aligning the tops of the fabrics (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- 6) Place another 4 ½" Fabric A square on the bottom half of the 4 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip, right sides together aligning the bottoms of the fabrics (Fig. 10). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 10). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 11).
- 7) Repeat Steps 5-6 to make twenty Unit 5 strips total.
- 8) Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 12-13 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientations to make thirty-one Unit 6 strips and twelve Unit 7 strips.
- 9) Sew one Unit 1 strip to the left side of one Unit 5 strip lengthwise to make one 8 ½" Block One square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make twenty Block One squares total.
- 10) Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figures 15-17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make fifteen Block Two squares, sixteen Block Three squares and twelve Block Four squares.
- 11) Sew together four Block One squares and three Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 18). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.
- 12) Sew together four Block Three squares and three Block Four squares, alternating them from left to right to make Row Two (Fig. 18). Repeat to make Row Four, Row Six and Row Eight.
- 13) Sew the nine rows from Steps 11-12 together lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom to make the Center Block (Fig. 18).

Quilt Assembly (refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top)

- 14) Sew one 2" x 72 ½" Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2" x 59 ½" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15) Sew one 4 ½" x 75 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 4 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the guilt top.
- 16) Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17) Sew the seven 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.

18) Bind as desired.
