## Fabric Requirements &amp; Cutting Guide

Quilt Size: 52" x 64"

- Fabric A- Music – Cream**                      **0577-1045**                      **5/8 yard**  
Cut two 8 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 8 1/2" squares.
- Fabric B- Stars – Dark Gray**                      **0579-1038**                      **1 yard**  
Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ninety-six 2 1/2" squares.  
Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
- Fabric C- Texture – Cream**                      **0581-1042**                      **2/3 yard**  
Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.  
Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" squares.
- Fabric D- Texture – Tan**                      **0581-1047**                      **1/2 yard**  
Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ninety-six 2 1/2" squares.
- Fabric E- Words – Dark Gray**                      **0578-1021**                      **5/8 yard**  
Cut two 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 8 1/2" squares.
- Fabric F- Stars – Light Gray**                      **0579-1022**                      **1/2 yard**  
Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy-two 2 1/2" squares.
- Fabric G- Stripe – Multi**                      **0583-1022**                      **1 yard**  
Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.  
Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.  
Cut two 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- Fabric H- Roses – Dark Gray**                      **0580-1018**                      **1 1/4 yards**  
Cut six 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut four 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- Backing- Words – Cream**                      **0578-1042**                      **3 1/2 yards**  
Cut two 60" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 60" x 72" back.

## Block Assembly

- Place one 2 1/2" Fabric B square on the top left corner of one 8 1/2" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2).
- Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 1/2" Fabric A square to make one Unit 1 block (Fig. 4).
- Repeat Steps 1-2 to make six Unit 1 blocks total.
- Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, location and seam direction to make (6) Unit 2 blocks.

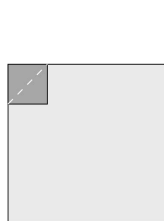

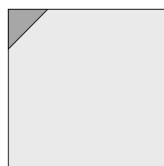

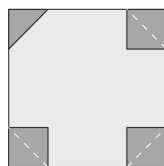

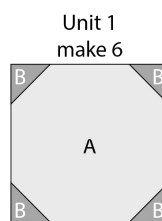

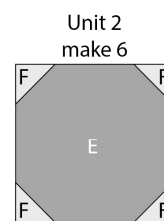
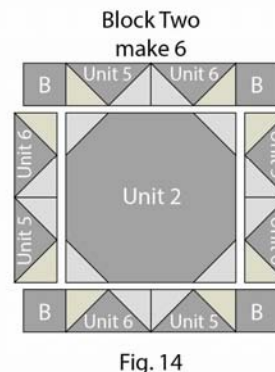
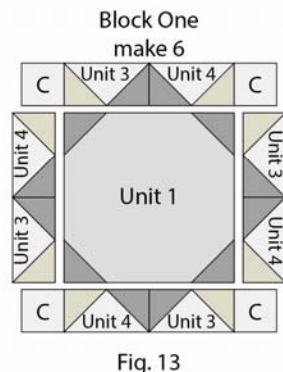
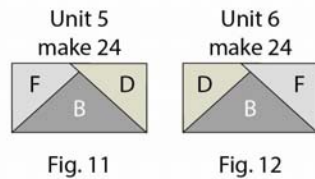
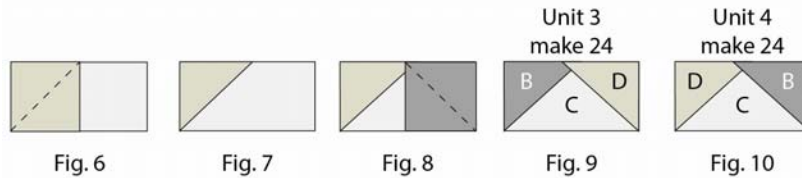

5. Place one 2 1/2" Fabric B square on the left side of one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 7).
6. Place one 2 1/2" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make one Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make twenty-four Unit 3 strips total.
8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figure 10-12 for fabric identification, location and seam direction to make (24) Unit 4 strips, twenty-four Unit 5 strips and twenty-four Unit 6 strips.
9. Sew one Unit 3 strip to the left side of one Unit 4 strip to make one Block One side strip. Repeat to make twenty-four Block One side strips total.
10. Sew one Block One side strip to each side of one Unit 1 block. Sew one 2 1/2" Fabric C square to end of one Block One side strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make one Block One square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make six Block One squares total.
11. Sew one Unit 5 strip to the left side of one Unit 6 strip to make one Block Two side strip. Repeat to make twenty-four side strips total.
12. Sew one Block Two side strip to each side of one Unit 2 block. Sew one 2 1/2" Fabric C square to end of one Block Two side strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 block to make one Block Two square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make six Block Two squares total.





**Quilt Assembly** (*refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top*)

Sew one Block One square to each side of one Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

Sew one Block Two square to each side of one Block One square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

Sew the four rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.

Sew one 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

Layer and quilt as desired.

Sew the six 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.

Bind as desired.
